

Frequently Asked Questions

- **How long does the COVID-19 Preparedness and Response Plan have to be?**

There is no page limit for the plan. It can be as detailed, or brief, as needed to explain your intentions. If you had a COVID-19 Preparedness and Response Plan in 2020, you could review and update as necessary for your 2021 plan.

- **What does the COVID-19 preparedness and response plan need to include?**

The plan needs to address how you will comply with the 2021 Migrant Labor Housing Emergency Rules. You can also use the checklist provided on MDARD's website.

- **Is there an example COVID-19 Preparedness and Response Plan?**

- **Where am I posting the COVID-19 Preparedness and Response Plan?**

You need to visibly post in a conspicuous location at each licensed housing camp. Typically, this would be where you post a copy of your license and/or work-related signage.

- **Who am I sending the COVID-19 Preparedness and Response Plan to?**

You will not need to send the COVID-19 Preparedness and Response Plan to anyone. However, be prepared to provide it to your MDARD Migrant Labor Housing Inspector during a scheduled inspection.

- **What if I cannot separate beds by six or more feet?**

Install a barrier between beds or other control and prevention measures as approved by MDARD. For additional guidance view the [COVID-19 Migrant Labor Housing Occupant Bed and Sleep Position Recommendations](#) located on the Migrant Labor Housing website.

- **What if I cannot provide housing for workers and family members, suspected COVID-19, and/or confirmed COVID-19?**

Contact your Migrant Labor Housing Inspector.

- **Will personal protection equipment be provided to me and my workers?**

MDARD does not have the capability to provide personal protection equipment.
