EGLE Releases Interim PFAS Guidance Document

The Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE) released the much-anticipated [Land Application of Biosolids Containing PFAS Interim Strategy](#) document that was shared with those who have an approved Residuals Management Program (RMP) across the state of Michigan. Some of the highlights: Mandatory testing of 28 PFAS compounds prior to any land application of Biosolids on or after July 1, 2021.
