The flesh of a pig or hog used as food.

Any of various mammals of the family Suidae, which includes the domesticated pig as well as wild species, such as the boar and the wart hog.

beef

The flesh of a slaughtered full-grown steer, bull, ox, or cow.

The common domestic fowl (*Gallus domesticus*) or its young.

duck

Any of various wild or domesticated swimming birds of the family Anatidae, characteristically having a broad, flat bill, short legs, and webbed feet.

mandarin duck

An Asian duck (*Aix galericulata*) having brightly colored plumage and a crested head.

egg

The round or oval female reproductive body of various animals, including birds, reptiles, amphibians, fishes, and insects, consisting usually of an embryo surrounded by nutrient material and a protective covering.

Any of numerous cold-blooded aquatic vertebrates of the superclass Pisces, characteristically having fins, gills, and a streamlined body and including specifically any of the class Osteichthyes, having a bony skeleton.

A plant cultivated for an edible part, such as the root of the beet, the leaves of spinach, or the flower buds of broccoli or cauliflower.
