

    - Luster Dust, Bulk Spices, Fish Speciation







- Radiological Emergency Preparedness
  - Prepared us to lead and succeed in REP IPX
  - Successful demonstration of sampling techniques to FEMA evaluator
- Spices
  - Warren session Cinnamon sample 3.82 ppm lead
  - Additional samples collected by FDA; health hazard confirmed
  - · Regulatory action by FDA
- Lusterdust
  - Some contained concerning levels of lead, cobalt, and cadmium
  - Additional labeling concerns
  - · Ongoing review with FDA
