

Noncompliant Hemp Crop Options

START

Preharvest sampling or grower compliance monitoring identifies a noncompliant lot

GROWER PICKS 1

*30 days to dispose of or remediate

DISPOSAL
select method of disposal and notify MDARD online at least 48 hours prior to disposal.

REMEDiation
select method of remediation and notify MDARD online at least 20 days prior to request resampling.

MDARD PICKS 1

Inspector schedules appointment to witness disposal. Inspector's report serves as grower's Notice of Disposal record. END.

Inspector does not witness disposal and informs grower. Grower conducts disposal and emails MDARD-Industrialhemp@michigan.gov with Notice of Disposal information that serves as disposal record. END.

GROWER PICKS 1

Option 1: Flower separation and disposal. All floral material is removed from plant and disposed of, while retaining stalks, leaves, and seeds. MDARD will collect a non-floral sample for THC testing and confirm disposal of floral material.

Option 2: Biomass creation. Entire lot is shredded into homogenous biomass, and MDARD collects biomass sample for THC testing.

30 Days to Dispose of

Floral Material

Material can enter stream of commerce: grower can sell to licensed hemp processors and marijuana processors licensed under Medical Marihuana Facilities Licensing Act.
