Reg. 637, Rule 12 [R285.637.12(3)] requires the information above to be provided in writing no later than at the time of each pesticide application or electronically within 48 hours after the application if the commercial applicator has the written approval of the customer prior to the application.

YOU ARE HEREBY ORDERED TO STOP THE PROHIBITED CONDUCT OF:

- Holding yourself out to the public as being in the business of applying pesticides until properly licensed as a Pesticide Application Business by MDARD, as required by Act 451 of 1994, Part 83, Pesticide Control, Section 8313(1).
- Applying pesticides for a commercial purpose or in the course of your employment until you are properly certified or registered by MDARD, as required by Act 451 of 1994, Part 83, Pesticide Control, Section 8314(1).
- Applying pesticides without using required personal protective equipment as required by Regulation 637, Rule 9 and by the pesticide label.
- Mixing, loading, or otherwise using pesticides until you have immediate access to a spill kit as required by Regulation 637, Rule 4.
- Using a pesticide in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Be advised that any item answered "No" indicates a violation of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, Act 451, Part 83, Pesticide Control; Regulation 636, and/or Regulation 637.
