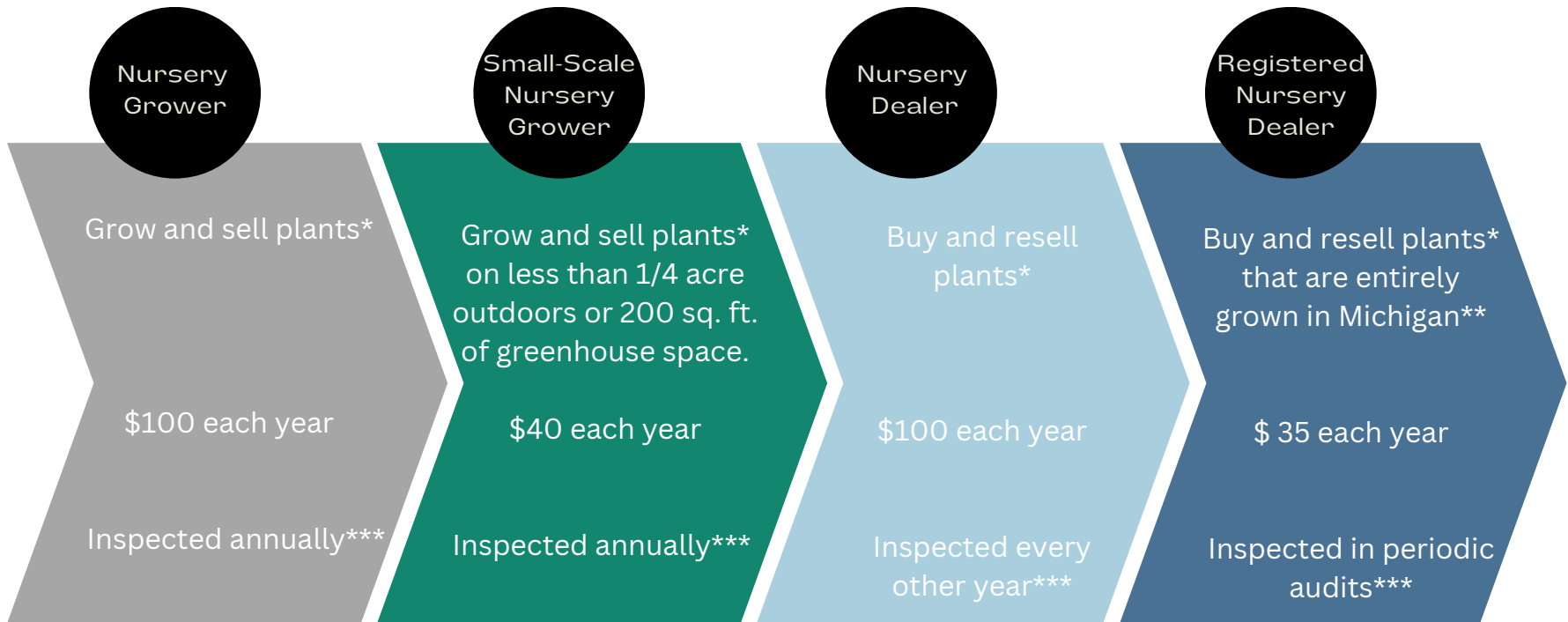


What Types of Nursery Licenses Are There?



Additional Information:

*Only winter-hardy nursery stock plants are subject to these licensing rules. These include trees, shrubs, perennials, fruit trees, berry plants, rose bushes, vines, herbs, and bulbs that can survive the winter without special care when planted outdoors in USDA zone 6 or less.

**Michigan-grown nursery stock means grown by a licensed Michigan nursery grower and inspected and certified by MDARD. Nursery stock purchased from a licensed nursery dealer (such as retail garden centers) does not qualify as Michigan grown.
