Delta Dental PPO (Point-of-Service) is a national point-of-service preferred provider organization administered by Delta Dental of Michigan. You can go to any licensed dentist, but you could increase your benefits and lower your out-of-pocket costs by going to a Delta Dental PPO dentist. If you do not go to a Delta Dental PPO dentist, you will have additional access to dentists who participate in Delta Dental Premier®, our carefully managed fee-for-service program. However, you might have to pay more. If you visit a dentist who does not participate in any of Delta Dental's programs, you will be responsible for the difference between Delta Dental's payment and the nonparticipating dentist's fee, and you may need to file your own claims.

<b>Diagnostic</b> – Includes routine and emergency oral exams. Oral Exams are limited to two times in a Plan year.	100%	100%	100%
<b>Preventive</b> – Includes prophylaxes, space maintainers, and fluoride treatments. Prophylaxes (teeth cleanings) are limited to three times in a Plan year. Fluoride treatments for enrolled dependents up to age 19; and space maintainers for enrolled	100%	100%	100%
<b>Radiographs</b> – X-rays as required for routine care or as necessary for the diagnosis of a specific condition. Covered services include full mouth X-rays once in every five years and bitewing X-rays once in a Plan year unless special need is shown.	100%	100%	100%

\* When you receive services from a Nonparticipating Dentist, the percentages in this column indicate the portion of Delta Dental's Nonparticipating Dentist Fee that will be paid for those services. This amount may be less than what the Dentist charges or Delta Dental approves and you are responsible for that difference.
