

EMPLOYMENT WITH THE STATE OF MICHIGAN

Application Process

The State of Michigan uses a web-based, vacancy-driven system to fill positions in the state classified service. Positions are posted at www.governmentjobs.com/careers/michigan through the NEOGOV application portal. Click the “Filter” button to modify active search criteria at any time. To receive automated email alerts when jobs of interest are posted, see the Menu at upper left to complete and submit a “Job Alert.”

To create a profile for the NEOGOV application portal, click the “**State Jobs** view current openings” button on the bottom left. First-time users must create an account with a username and password. Once the account is established, applicants use their Profile to apply for job openings; the content can be modified at-will. For postings that indicate college credits or a degree is required, a copy of the applicant’s official transcript(s) must be attached to the application.
