The state employer proposes amendments to rule 5-6.4 to expand eligibility for the existing premium for Department of Treasury field auditors to eligible auditor staff in the department's tax compliance field audit division. Staff proposes conforming, non-substantive amendments to rule 2-14.3's reference to rule 5-6.4 to reflect the proposed change. The proposed amendments are shown in the attachment.
