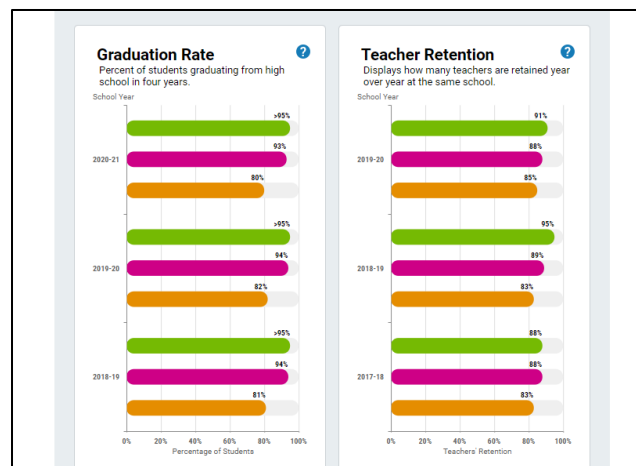

In 2019, Gov. Whitmer set a goal to increase the percentage of Michigan adults with postsecondary degrees or certificates to 60% by the year 2030. In support of this initiative, the Postsecondary Attainment: Progress Toward Sixty by 30 Education Focus Area was added to MI School Data. This report combines data from the Lumina Foundation, National Student Clearinghouse, and CEPI to explore postsecondary enrollment, persistence, and completion of Michigan students and track progress toward this goal.

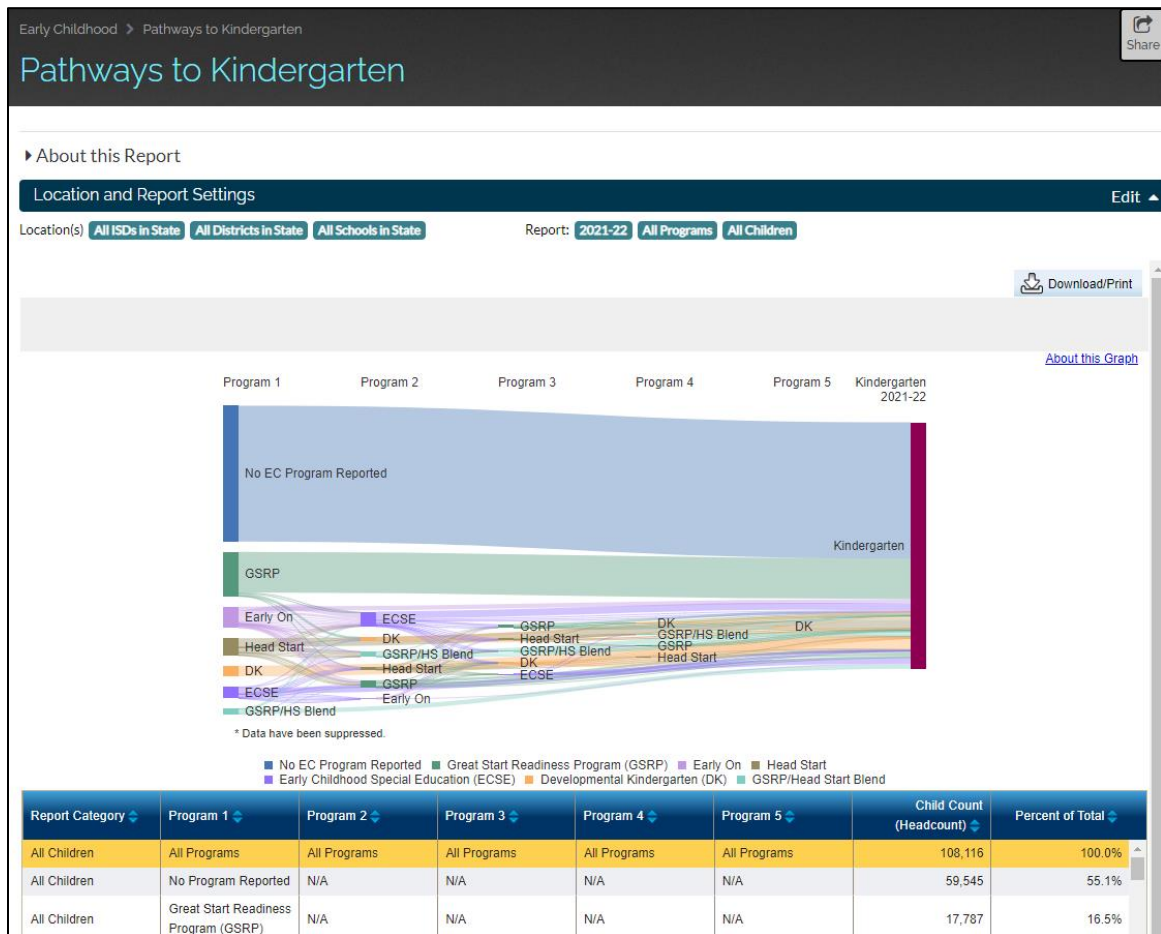

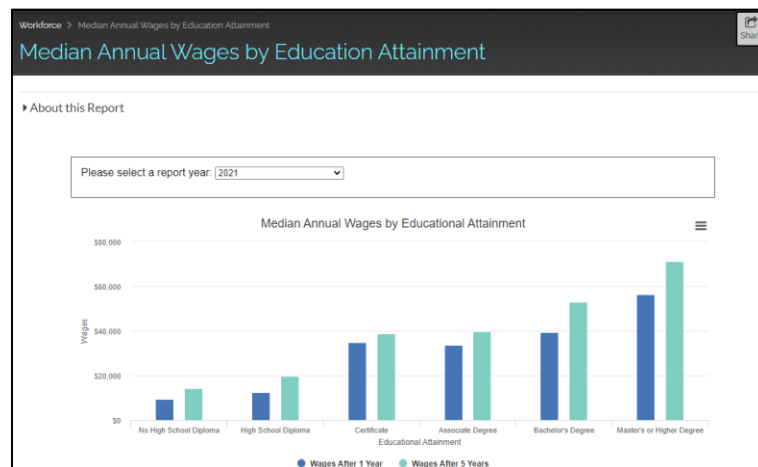
