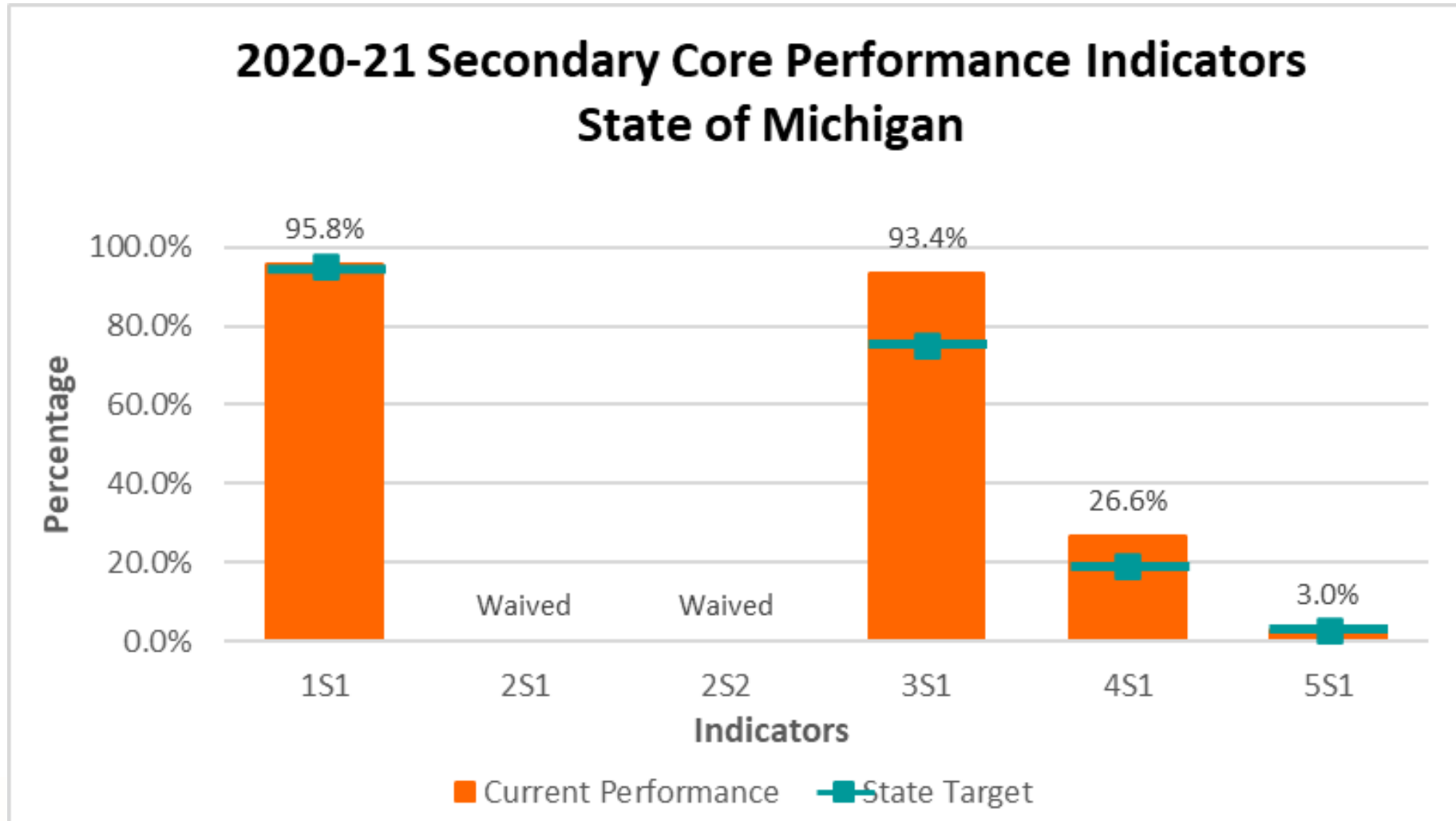
Perkins V CPIs

- 4-Year Graduation Rate
- Academic Proficiency
 - Reading/Language Arts
 - Mathematics
 - Science
- Post-Program Placement
- Nontraditional Program Concentration
- Program Quality - Attained Recognized Postsecondary Credential

2020-21 Enrollment

- 84,971 participants in 2021 (12.8% decrease)
- 56,170 concentrators in 2021 (12.7% decrease)
 - Change of participant definition to 4+ segments
 - Change of concentrator definition to 8+ segments
 - COVID-19 pandemic, total high school enrollment decreased

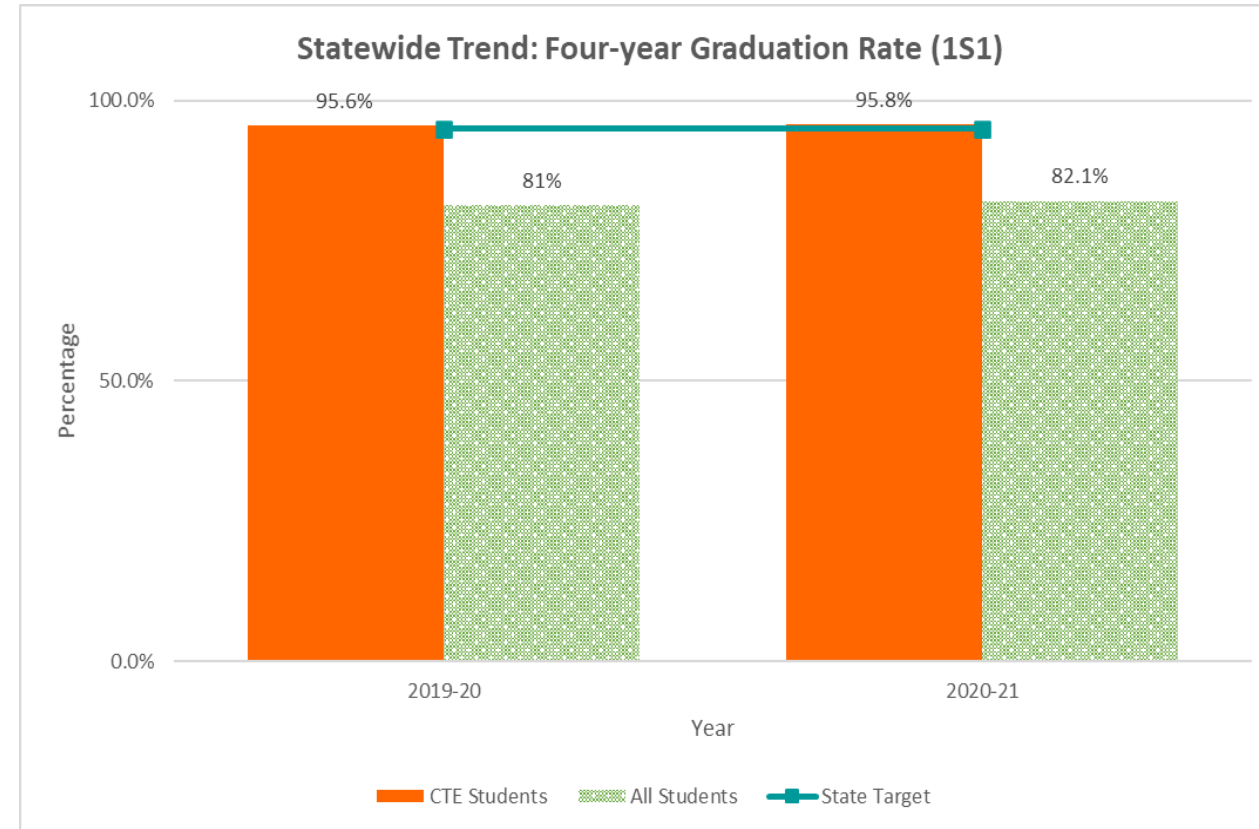

Perkins V 1S1: 4-Year Graduation Rate

- Measure
 - CTE concentrators who were part of the 4-year cohort
 - CTE concentrators who graduated during the reporting year
 - The same as ESSA four-year cohort graduation rate measure
- 2020-21 Performance: 95.8%
- 2021-22 Target: 95.0% (90% of the target is 85.5%)

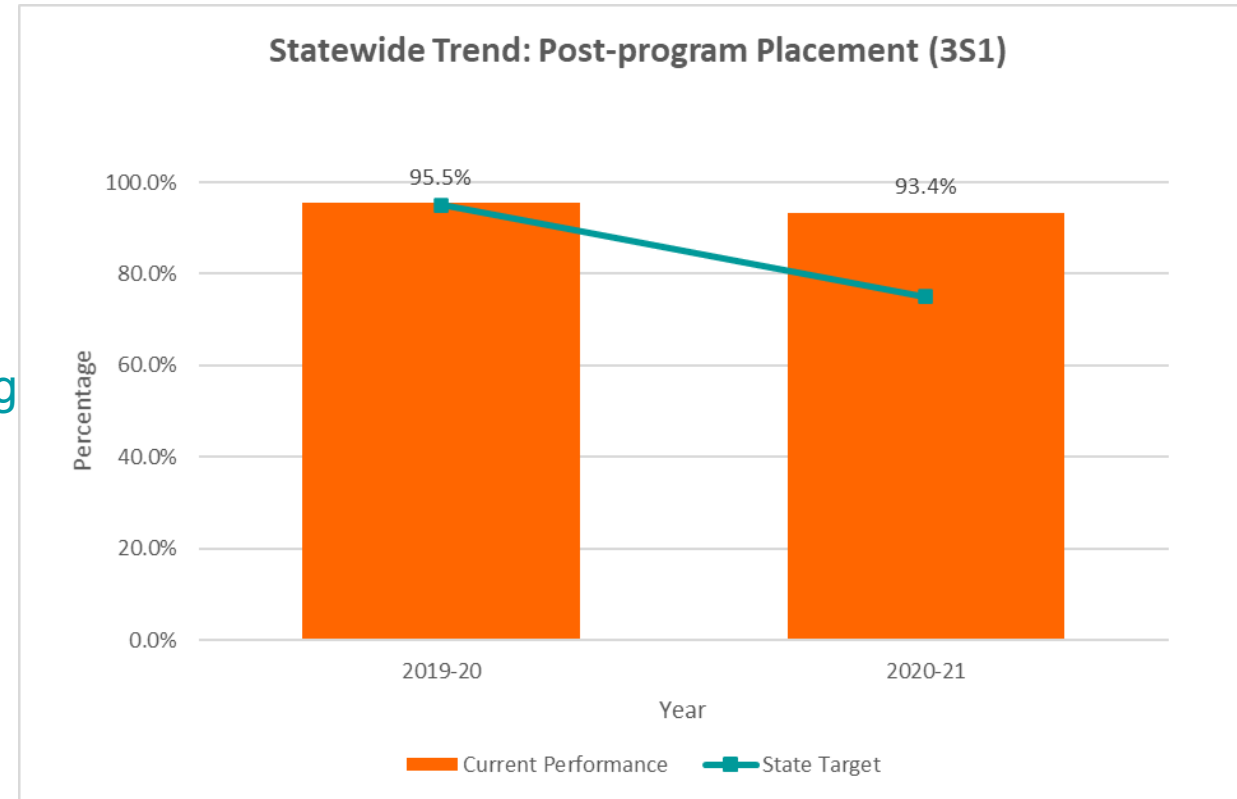


Perkins V 2S1, 2S2, 2S3: Academic Proficiency

- Measure
 - CTE concentrators who have taken the ESSA assessments and left school during reporting year
 - Achieved proficiency in Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) academic assessment
- 2020-21 Performance
 - 2S1: N/A
 - 2S2: N/A
 - 2S3: N/A
- 2021-22 Targets
 - 2S1 Target: TBD
 - 2S2 Target: TBD
 - 2S3 Target: Waived

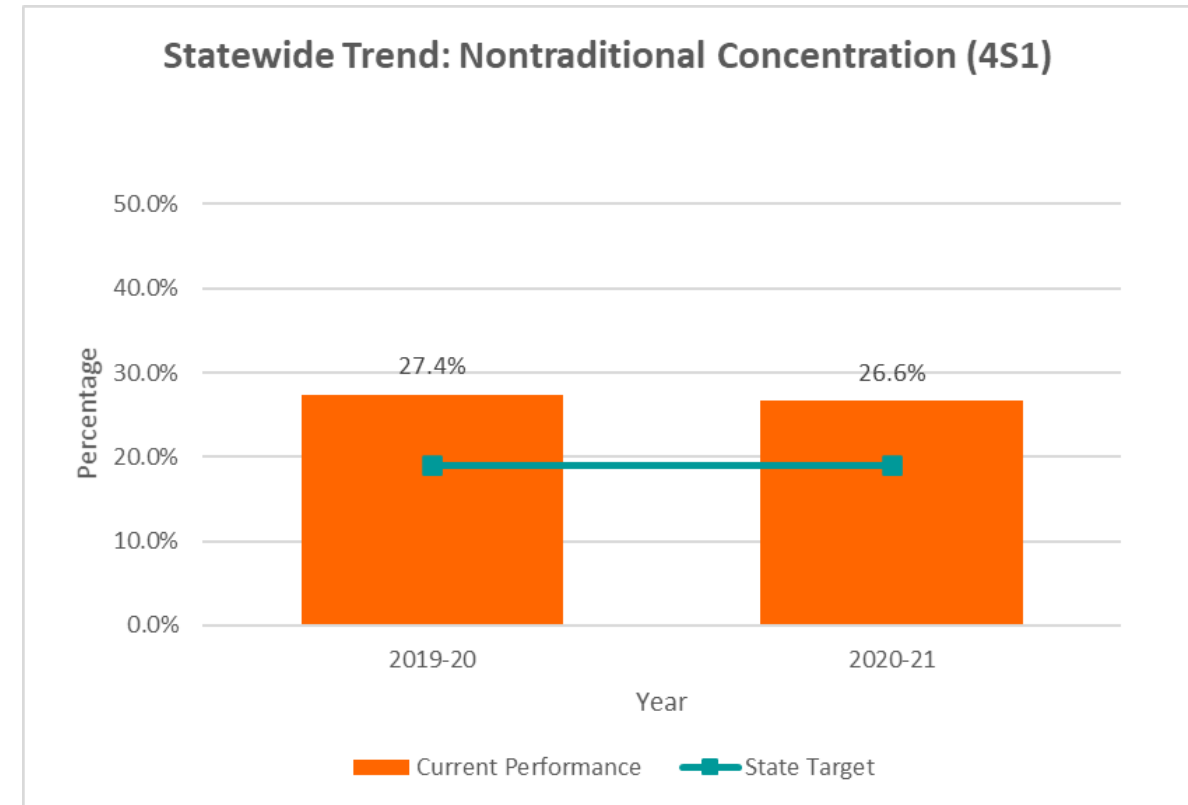
Perkins V 3S1: Post-Program Placement

- Measure
 - CTE concentrators who responded to the follow-up survey and left school during the reporting year.
 - In a placement 2nd quarter after existing high school
 - Postsecondary Education/Advanced Training
 - Employment
 - Military Service
 - National and Community Service Programs
 - Peace Corps Volunteers
- 2020-21 Performance: 93.4%



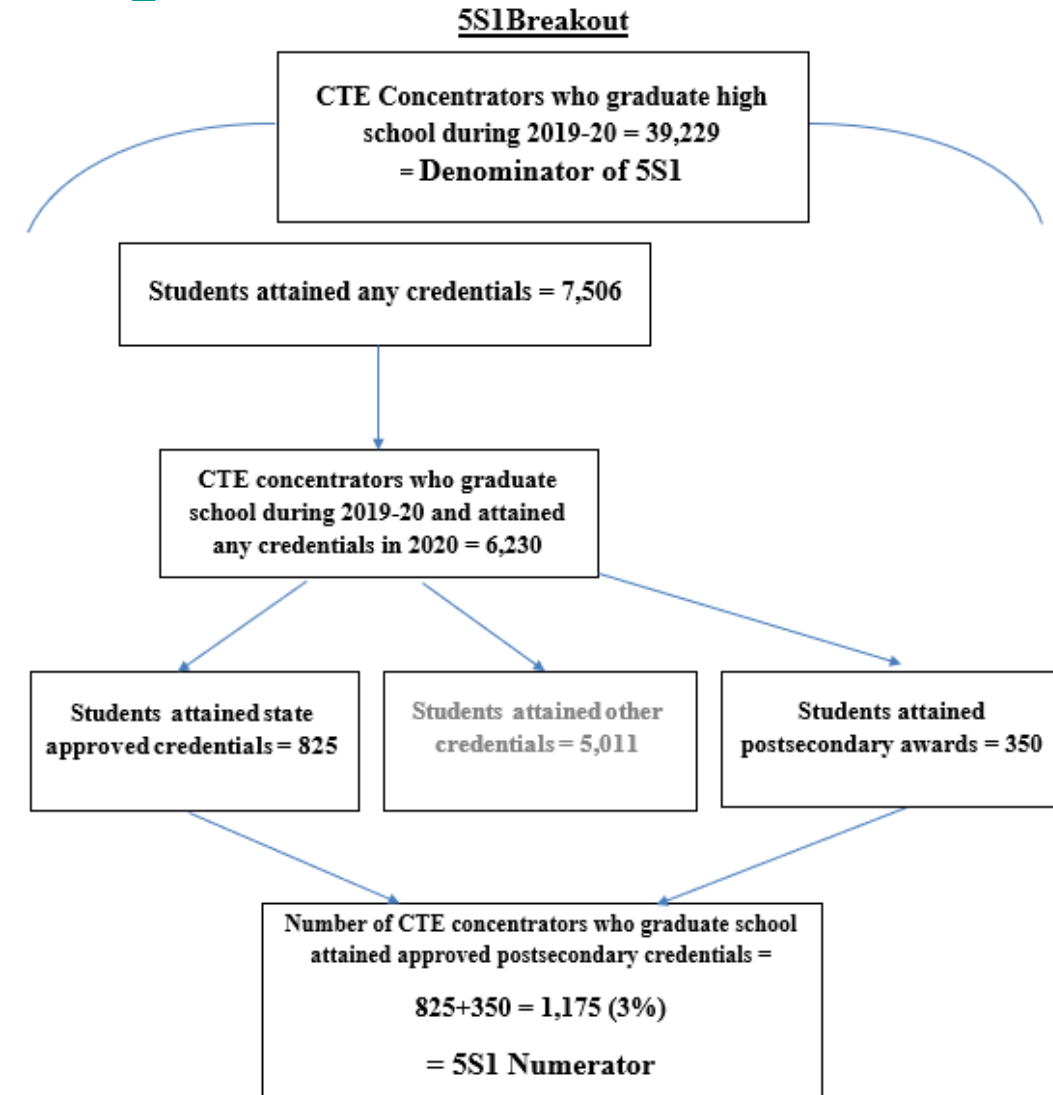
Perkins V 4S1: Nontraditional Program Concentration

- Measure
 - CTE concentrators in a CTE program that leads to a nontraditional field
 - Underrepresented gender groups in nontraditional CTE programs
- 2020-21 Performance: 26.6%
- 2021-22 Target: 19.25% (90% of the target is 17.3%)



Perkins V 5S1: Program Quality - Attained Recognized Postsecondary Credential

- Measure
 - CTE concentrators who graduated from high school during the reporting year
 - Having attained a recognized postsecondary credential
 - Pre-approved Credentials
 - Postsecondary awards
- 2020-21 Performance: 3%
- 2021-22 Target: 5.5% (90% of the target is 4).

Performance | 2020-2021: 1s1 - Graduation Rate (Overall)





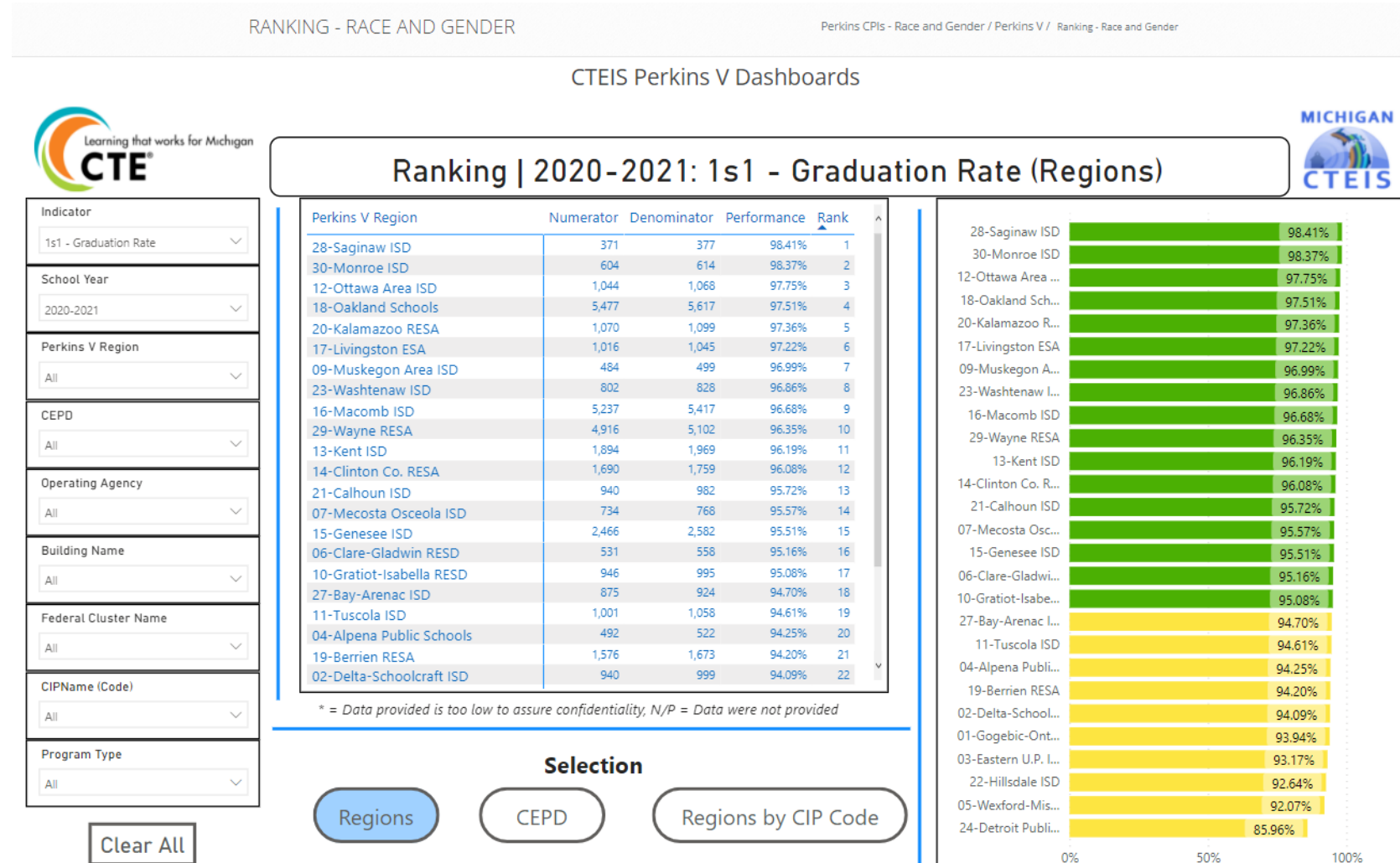


● Performance ■ State Target ▲ 90% of State Target


