## 2020-21 Enrollment


- 84,971 participants in 2021 (12.8% decrease)



## **Perkins V 1S1: 4-Year Graduation Rate**

- Measure
  - CTE concentrators who were part of the 4-year cohort
  - CTE concentrators who graduated during the reporting year
  - The same as ESSA four-year cohort graduation rate measure
- 2020-21 Performance: 95.8%
- 2021-22 Target: 95.0% (90% of the target is 85.5%)







## Perkins V 3S1: Post-Program Placement

- 2020-21 Performance: 93.4%








### **Perkins V 4S1: Nontraditional Program Concentration**

#### • Measure

- CTE concentrators in a CTE program that leads to a nontraditional field
- Underrepresented gender groups in nontraditional CTE programs
- 2020-21 Performance: 26.6%
- 2021-22 Target: 19.25% (90% of the target is 17.3%)








### Perkins V 5S1: Program Quality - Attained Recognized Postsecondary Credential




