

**Michigan Perkins V Secondary Performance
Local Program Evaluation and Improvement Policy**

The Carl D. Perkins Career and Technical Education Act of 2006 as amended by the [Strengthening Career and Technical Education for the 21st Century Act](#) (Public Law 88-210; December 18, 1963 [As Amended Through P.L. 116-6, Enacted February 15, 2019]) provides for states to take action if an eligible recipient of Perkins funds fails to meet at least 90 percent of an agreed upon local level of performance for any of the core indicators of performance [section 123 (b)]. This document outlines Michigan’s policy regarding failure to meet core indicators of performance.

Recipient fails to meet at least 90% of the local level of performance for the core indicator for 3 consecutive years. [§123(b)(3); §123(b)(4)(A)(ii)]	MDE-OCTE shall work with the region to implement improvement activities consistent with the requirements of the act. MDE-OCTE actions may include mandated funding requirements and/or MDE-OCTE may withhold all, or a portion of the regional Perkins grant.	Region fiscal agency superintendent and region CEPD Administrators will be notified by letter of failure to make improvement, and of MDE-OCTE provision of technical assistance and potential funding sanction.	Region must implement improvement activities consistent with the requirements of the act, in consultation with MDE-OCTE.	Region may submit written appeal and/or request for waiver for exceptional circumstances, to the State Director of Career and Technical Education, within 14 days of receipt of notification.
