

## **Perkins V Executive Committee Secondary and Postsecondary Executive Summary**

The purpose of the [Strengthening Career and Technical Education for the 21st Century Act \(Perkins V\) Act](#) is to develop more fully the academic knowledge and technical and employability skills of secondary education students and postsecondary education students who elect to enroll in career and technical education programs and programs of study.

The Perkins V Executive committee was convened by the Michigan Departments of Labor and Economic Opportunity (LEO) and Education (MDE) in 2019 to provide ongoing stakeholder input and consultation in development and implementation of [Michigan's State Plan for Career and Technical Education](#) under the Carl D. Perkins Strengthening Career and Technical Education for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Act.

The Perkins V Executive committee includes representatives from secondary and postsecondary education as well as community and employer representatives. Four Perkins V referent groups provide input consultation on ongoing implementation of the Perkins state plan and update the Perkins V Executive Committee at least annually. These referent groups include High Quality Programs of Study, Comprehensive Local Needs Assessment, Accountability, and Special Populations.

The Perkins V Executive Committee provides ongoing stakeholder input on implementation of Michigan's State Plan for Perkins and secondary and postsecondary career and technical education in Michigan. The Perkins V Executive Committee is convened one or two times per year.
