**Articulation Agreement for All State-Approved Michigan CTE
Careers in Education Programs and ADRIAN COLLEGE**

The purpose of this agreement is to facilitate the transition of a student from high school and/or Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs to Adrian College. Program is offered at all **State-Approved Career and Technical Education Programs in Michigan.**

General Conditions and Requirements:

1. Students must apply for Articulated Credit at Adrian College within two years of high school graduation.
2. Student must complete the Articulated Credit Application/Verification form- located on the Adrian College website (<http://adrian.edu/academics/academic-departments/teacher-education/overview/>), gather necessary documentation, obtain appropriate signatures, and request that the career technical center/high school send the form and documentation to Adrian College Office of Transfer and Secondary School Partnerships.
3. Students must complete both years of the secondary career technical education course competencies with a "B" or better final grade.
