



College for Creative Studies Postsecondary Credit Agreement

This Postsecondary Credit Agreement is made and entered into as of March 20th, 2024, by the Michigan Department of Education (MDE) and the College for Creative Studies. The agreement is for state-approved secondary career technical education (CTE) programs. Separate agreements should be submitted for each state-approved CTE secondary CIP Code number.

Purpose of this Agreement:

- 1) Expand educational opportunities for high school students allowing them to earn postsecondary credits.
- 2) Eliminate unnecessary duplication of course materials and instruction.
- 3) Maximize the use of resources for students to complete programs as efficiently as possible.
- 4) Support postsecondary enrollment, retention, and completion.

General Conditions & Requirements:

1. Candidates for postsecondary credit through this agreement must apply and be accepted to the College for Creative Studies (CCS) prior to being awarded articulation credit.
2. A total of 6 credits in Foundation (DFN) will be applied toward degree requirements.
3. The CCS office of admissions reserves the right to apply Credit toward required studio courses if outcomes have been satisfied. This is determined upon review of the student's portfolio.
4. Application for postsecondary credit must be completed and submitted by the secondary CTE program representative and student and received by the CCS Office of Admissions within three years of the student's high school graduation.
5. Students who complete one year of the program with a 'B' (3.0) or above, students will be eligible to earn 3 articulated credits (one course). Those students who complete both years of the program and earn a grade of 'B' (3.0) or above will be eligible to earn 6 articulated credits (two courses). See next page for details.
