**Postsecondary Credit Agreement**

This Postsecondary Credit Agreement is made and entered into as of August 1, 2023, by the Michigan Department of Education (MDE) and Baker College. The agreement is for state-approved secondary career technical education (CTE) programs. Separate agreements should be submitted for each state-approved CTE secondary CIP Code number.

**Purpose of this Agreement:**

- 1) Expand educational opportunities for high school students allowing them to earn postsecondary credits.
- 2) Eliminate unnecessary duplication of course materials and instruction.
- 3) Maximize the use of resources for students to complete programs as efficiently as possible.
- 4) Support postsecondary enrollment, retention, and completion.

2. Student must complete the CTE program (inclusive of the identified segments/competencies) with a "B-" or higher average in order to be eligible for articulation.
3. Student must complete the application for articulation (with instructor signature) and have a current high school transcript, including grades for all parts of the CTE program, sent to [runningstart@baker.edu](mailto:runningstart@baker.edu)
