# Postsecondary Credit Agreement/Articulation Agreement

This Postsecondary Credit Agreement/Articulation Agreement is made and entered into as of **November 1, 2023** by the Michigan Department of Education (MDE) and Mott Community College. The agreement is for state-approved secondary career technical education (CTE) programs. Separate agreements should be submitted for each state-approved CTE secondary CIP Code number.

### Purpose of this Agreement:

- 1) Expand educational opportunities for high school students allowing them to earn postsecondary credits.
- 2) Eliminate unnecessary duplication of course materials and instruction.
- 3) Maximize the use of resources for students to complete programs as efficiently as possible.
- 4) Support postsecondary enrollment, retention, and completion.

#### **General Conditions & Requirements:**

- 1. Students must enroll at MCC and apply for articulated credit within three years of high school graduation.
- 2. Students must enroll in a related program of study for credits to apply to an associate degree or certificate.
- 3. Articulated credit will be posted on the student transcript upon completion of the above requirements and successful completion (2.0 or better) of one additional course in the program.
- 4. A minimum of 15 credits of satisfactory work must be earned at MCC to be eligible for graduation with an associate degree or a certificate of achievement.
