Postsecondary Credit Agreement

This Postsecondary Credit Agreement is made and entered into as of January 1, 2026, by the Michigan Department of Education (MDE) and Macomb Community College. The agreement is for state-approved secondary career technical education (CTE) programs. Separate agreements should be submitted for each state-approved CTE secondary CIP Code number.

Purpose of this Agreement:

- 1) Expand educational opportunities for high school students allowing them to earn postsecondary credits.
- 2) Eliminate unnecessary duplication of course materials and instruction.
- 3) Maximize the use of resources for students to complete programs as efficiently as possible.
- 4) Support postsecondary enrollment, retention, and completion.

1. Students must successfully complete all the required courses in a state-approved CTE Architecture program under CIP code 15.1301.
2. Student must apply and be admitted to Macomb Community College.
3. Students must request credit by emailing hsarticulations@macomb.edu to obtain the MCC Application for Articulation Credit.
4. Students must submit an official high school transcript showing program completion.
5. Students must earn a grade of 75% or "C", or better in all articulated courses.
