Postsecondary Credit Agreement

This Postsecondary Credit Agreement is made and entered into as of **July 1, 2024**, by the Michigan Department of Education (MDE) and Gogebic Community College (GCC). The agreement is for state-approved secondary career technical education (CTE) programs.

Purpose of this Agreement:

- 1) Expand educational opportunities for high school students allowing them to earn postsecondary credits.
- 2) Eliminate unnecessary duplication of course materials and instruction.
- 3) Maximize the use of resources for students to complete programs as efficiently as possible.
- 4) Support postsecondary enrollment, retention, and completion.

General Conditions & Requirements:

1. To earn post-secondary credits, the secondary school instructor will certify that the student achievement and attendance within the articulated course is at or above the 80% level. This will be transcribed on the high school transcript as a grade of B or higher.
2. Application for postsecondary credit must be received within two years of the student's high school graduation. Exceptions to this condition must be approved by the Vice President of Student Services and Athletics.
3. The student must have an official high school transcript on file at GCC to verify completion of the CTE coursework.
4. No tuition will be charged for any courses for which the student receives postsecondary/articulated credit.

Credit for students is approved for the following course(s) based upon the passage of the relevant CTE course/program or corresponding credentialing exams. All conditions and requirements must be fulfilled.


