

Steps to Build a Statewide Postsecondary Credit Agreement/Articulation Agreement



Steps:

1. Reach out to postsecondary institutions to discuss collaboration and developing statewide agreements.
2. Develop an agenda for the meeting.
3. Assist the postsecondary institutions with reviewing the CTE Program skills and standards and determine alignment with college course(s).
4. Create statewide agreements, including the alignment of courses and the criteria to earn the credit.
5. Review and consider credentials for credit.
6. Request approval and support from MDE.
7. Credit is awarded by postsecondary institution.
