Postsecondary Partners

Colleges and Universities are important partners for EMC programs and provide the connection to the postsecondary coursework. EMCs must have a primary postsecondary partner, and there is no limit to the number of additional postsecondary partners they can add. There is no limit on the number of EMCs an individual postsecondary institution can partner with.

To add an additional partner, the EMC should send a copy of the signed Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) and the program of study between the EMC and new postsecondary partner to MDE.
