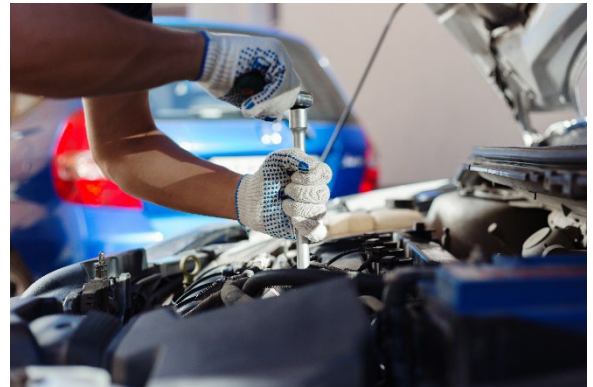

Exam Accommodations

ASE provides testing accommodations, under the provisions of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), to individuals who need accommodations to take the ASE certification tests. To request accommodations, please follow these steps:

1. Download [the ADA Request Form](#), or call ASE Customer Service at 1-800-390-6789 to receive the form by e-mail or fax.
2. The form must be completed by a qualified, appropriate professional, such as a physician for physical disability or psychologist for learning disability. The completed form must state the nature of the disability, how it affects their ability to take a computer-based, timed, multiple choice test, as well as the type of accommodations needed. 3. Return the completed form and all supporting documentation to the address listed on the form. Please do not register or schedule an appointment until after the request has been evaluated and approved by ASE.
