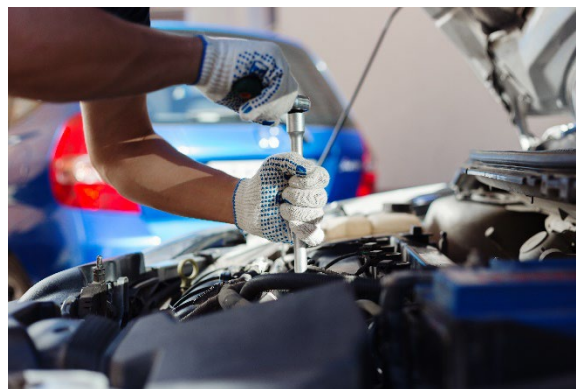

Exam Accommodations

ASE provides testing accommodations, under the provisions of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), to individuals who need accommodations to take the ASE certification tests. To request accommodations, please follow these steps:

2. The form must be completed by a qualified, appropriate professional, such as a physician for physical disability or psychologist for learning disability). The completed form must state the nature of your disability, how it affects your ability to take a computer-based, timed, multiple choice test, as well as the type of accommodations needed.
