Michigan lawmakers have appropriated funding that YOUR DISTRICT can utilize to build, strengthen, and brand your career pathways and expand work-based learning opportunities. In partnership with NAF, the Michigan Department of Education will administer these funds through a grant process to expand NAF academies. The grant will cover admissions fees to participate in a customized developmental process for designing a NAF academy – providing even more young people with access to opportunity.

Applicants can select a career-connected program of study within NAF's five career pathways: Engineering, Finance, Health Sciences, Hospitality & Tourism, or Information Technology. NAF also approves programs of study that align with the 16 career clusters as defined by the U.S. Department of Education's <u>National Career Clusters Framework</u>.

ABOUT US

NAF is a national non-profit organization that transforms the high school experience by bringing together secondary education, business, and community leaders to prepare student s for college, career, and future success. NAF's design is uniquely comprehensive in its approach to skills development, enabling students of all backgrounds to participate in a meaningful education and is a proven, low-cost strategy for enhancing school systems and raising student achievement – primarily in under-invested in communities.

NAF academies fit within the high school setting and typically focus on one of five career pathways: Finance, Engineering, Health Sciences, Hospitality & Tourism, or Information Technology. The academies teach industry-specific curricula and connect the content to the real world, while businesses have the unique opportunity to shape America's future workforce by amplifying the learning environment to integrate work-based learning experiences, mentoring, internships, and more.

During the 2023-24 school year, more than 113,000 students attended 619 NAF academies across 34 states, plus Washington DC, Puerto Rico, and the US Virgin Island. In 2023, NAF academies reported 99% of seniors graduated with 89% of graduates planning to go to college.
