Child Nutrition Programs (CNP) Bulletin No. 12 - Hillshire Brands and Foster Farms Corn Dog Recalls - October 7, 2025

The Michigan Department of Education (MDE) Office of Nutrition Services (ONS) wants to let you know about two corn dog product recalls.

Two manufacturers – [Hillshire Brands Company \(Sept. 27\)](#) and [Foster Farms \(Oct. 4\)](#) – recalled corn dog products that may be contaminated with extraneous material, specifically pieces of wood embedded in the batter.

The problem was discovered after The United State Department of Agriculture (USDA) Food Safety and Inspection Service (FSIS) received consumer complaints involving an injury from consumption of these products. Both establishments received multiple consumer complaints, 5 of which involved injuries.

Recalled products were not part of food distributed by the USDA for the National School Lunch Program. However, the products may have been purchased by some schools through commercial channels. Consumers and institutions, including schools, who have purchased these products are urged not to consume them. These products should be thrown away or returned to the place of purchase.
