Michigan Department of Education (MDE), Office of Nutrition Services, is submitting a waiver request to the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA). The waiver request is to adjust the timeline for annual Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) deadlines for School Year 2025-2026. 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To file a program discrimination complaint, a Complainant should complete a Form AD-3027, USDA Program Discrimination Complaint Form which can be obtained online at: <u>USDA Program Discrimination Complaint Form</u>, from any USDA office, by calling (866) 632-9992, or by writing a letter addressed to USDA. The letter must contain the complainant's name, address, telephone number, and a written description of the alleged discriminatory action in sufficient detail to inform the Assistant Secretary for Civil Rights (ASCR) about the nature and date of an alleged civil rights violation.
