#### SMARTER BALANCED INTERIM ASSESSMENTS OVERVIEW

The Michigan Smarter Balanced Interim Assessments are high quality assessments that are fully aligned to Michigan Standards. Students are tested on what they are taught in Michigan classrooms. These assessments allow educators to check student progress throughout the year, providing information which can be used to improve instruction.

The Smarter Balanced Interim Assessments are administered using the same test engine and test management platform Michigan educators use for the M-STEP, MI-Access, Early Literacy & Mathematics Benchmarks, and WIDA assessments, minimizing educator time spent on test set-up and administration.

Student performance on Interim Comprehensive Assessments (ICAs) is reported on the same scoring scale as the summative assessment and therefore are predictive of student performance on the M-STEP summative assessments.

Districts and schools have the flexibility to administer the Interim Assessments up to 10 times during the school year.

The Smarter Balanced Interim Assessments are free to Michigan districts and schools through funding provided by the State of Michigan and are fully integrated with the Michigan Data Hub.

Student reports are intuitive and user friendly, with fast results and the ability to track student progress over time.

Assessments results are linked to the *Tools for Teachers* digital platform, a rich resource created by teachers with materials, activities, and lessons that can be used to improve student learning.

#### **Types of SBAC Interim Assessments**

- Interim Comprehensive Assessments (ICAs) assess the full range of targets, measuring similar content as the M-STEP summative assessment.
- Interim Assessment Blocks (IABs) assess targets in Math or ELA/Literacy and can be used throughout the year
  to assess smaller bundles of content.
- **Focused IABs** used to assess up to three assessment targets to gain a detailed understanding of student learning.

#### **Interim Comprehensive Assessments (ICAs) Testing Times**

It is recommended that the two parts of the ICAs should be scheduled as separate sessions. The Interim Assessments **do not** lock overnight, so students can continue testing on subsequent days without any special intervention. Testing times provided in the table are approximate and are supplied for scheduling purposes only.

**Note**: These estimates do not include transition to the test room, distribution of test tickets, reading directions, or logging into the test.



ELA/Literacy	3-5	1:30
ELA/Literacy	6-8	1:30
Mathematics	3-5	1:30
Mathematics	6-8	2:00
Both	3-5	3:00
Both	6-8	3:30

### **Interim Assessment Blocks (IABs) Testing Times**

The Interim Assessment Blocks (IABs) include the same item types and formats but are shorter and focus on smaller sets of concepts than the ICAs and Summative assessment. Each IAB has 6-18 items and can generally be completed in one class period. The IAB Performance Task and Brief Write forms for ELA take approximately 2 hours. The IAB Performance Tasks for math take approximately 1 hour.

**Note:** Some IABs require educator scoring by the site. Educator Scoring is done through the DRC INSIGHT Portal. Until any applicable educator scoring is completed, only raw scores will be available.





#### **USER SETUP**

 Participating students will need to be added to test sessions created in the DRC INSIGHT portal by sites. Students will not be pulled from the Secure Site for the Smarter Balanced Interim Assessments.

#### Adding New Users to the DRC INSIGHT Portal

Users will automatically be provided permissions to the Smarter Balanced Interim Assessments in the DRC INSIGHT Portal. These users may add additional users for their-sites. User accounts with the Smarter Balanced Interim Assessments administration will include access to *Tools for Teachers*. Permissions for *Tools for Teachers* is provided in the District, School, and Teacher permission sets.

- 1. New users can be added in the User Management section of the DRC INSIGHT Portal (<a href="https://mi.drcedirect.com">https://mi.drcedirect.com</a>) by a user with the same or greater permissions.
- School personnel who do not yet have a DRC INSIGHT Portal account should check with their District or Building Coordinator for access as a new user at your site. If no one in your district has a DRC INSIGHT Portal account with the current year's Smarter Balanced Interim Assessments, please reach out to DRC Customer Service.

## In-person Testing Using the DRC INSIGHT Secure Web-Based Test Engine

Access the DRC INSIGHT secure web-based test engine for in-person testing by double-clicking the DRC INSIGHT icon on the student testing device.







Under the Smarter Balanced Interim Assessments icon, select the Online Tools Training link to launch the OTT or select the Test Sign-In link to log into an actual test.



On the Test Sign-In page, the student can log into their test using the credentials on their test ticket.

#### Remote Testing via a URL

Remote Testing is offered for the Smarter Balanced Interim Assessments using the DRC INSIGHT test engine, which will be accessed via a URL and launched in a public browser. More information, along with the remote testing URL, can be found in the DRC INSIGHT Portal.

- 1. Log into your DRC INSIGHT Portal account and navigate to My Applications > General Information > Documents.
- 2. Filter the Administration for the current year's **Smarter Balanced Interim Assessments** and the Document Type to **Remote Testing.**
- 3. Select the DRC INSIGHT Remote Testing URL, Links, and Contacts for the Smarter Balanced Interim Testing document.
- 4. Click on the remote testing URL link in the documents and the Smarter Balanced Interim Assessment Test Sign-In page will launch.
- 5. On the Test Sign-In page, enter the credentials on the student test ticket to begin the test.



#### THE SMARTER BALANCED REPORTING SYSTEM

#### **Accessing the Smarter Balanced Reporting System**

Access for the Smarter Balanced Reporting System is provided to users with a DRC INSIGHT Portal account and access to the Smarter Balanced Interim Assessments administration. Permission to access Smarter Reporting is provided in the District, School, and Teacher permission sets.

- Log into your DRC INSIGHT Portal Account
   (https://mi.drcedirect.com) and navigate to My Applications > SBAC > Smarter Reporting (note: options will vary based on permissions).
- When you click on the Smarter Reporting link in the DRC INSIGHT Portal, you will be automatically redirected to the Smarter Balanced Reporting System.



## **Setting Up and Assigning Student Groups**

District or School users will need to set up Student Groups and assign them to Teachers in the Smarter Balanced Reporting System. This will provide Teachers access to their students in the Smarter Balanced Reporting System. **Important!** Teacher email address MUST match the email used for the Teacher in the DRC INSIGHT Portal. In addition, student information MUST match the student information in the DRC INSIGHT Portal.




#### **ACCESSING TOOLS FOR TEACHERS**

**Tools for Teachers** is available to *all* Michigan educators—even if they do not use the Smarter Balanced Interim Assessments. This online resource provides materials, lessons, and strategies aligned to state standards.

To access **Tools for Teachers**, educators need a DRC INSIGHT Portal account with permission for the Smarter Balanced Interim Assessments. Educators who have not previously had a DRC INSIGHT Portal account can be added by sites as new users for the Smarter Balanced Interim Assessments, even if it is only to access **Tools for Teachers**. Permission for **Tools for Teachers** is provided in the District, School, and Teacher permission sets.


- Log into the DRC INSIGHT Portal (https://mi.drcedirect.com).
  - a. If you do not yet have a Portal account, check with your District or Building Coordinator to request to be added as a new user at your site.

2. In the DRC INSIGHT Portal, navigate to My Applications > SBAC, then click the *Tools for Teachers* link (note: options will vary based on permissions).

When you click on the *Tools for Teachers* link in the DRC INSIGHT Portal, you will be automatically redirected to *Tools for Teachers*.

On the **Tools for Teachers** main page, click the left-hand menu to see the menu options, type a topic, claim, or target in the search box, or click the filter resources link.





