

Parental/Guardian Opt-Out-Form for Optional Student Information (E-mail Address) Provided in the WIN Career Readiness System

Your child will take the WIN Work Readiness Assessments as part of the Michigan Merit Exam (MME). The WIN Work Readiness Assessments which measure foundational workplace math, reading and data analysis skills. The Work Readiness Assessments result in a nationally recognized credential: the National Work Readiness Credential – Academic Skills in Achievement Levels 2-5.

While every student who earns at least a level 2 credential will have access to a printable credential with their WIN Career Readiness System login, WIN Learning also offers access to digital credentials. Digital credentials enable students to share their achievements via social media platforms such as LinkedIn and on their resume.

To participate, students must provide a valid email address where they will receive a link to their digital wallet, where their digital credentials are collected.

Advantages to signing up for digital achievements include:

- **Always accessible:** Digital credentials will always be available in their digital wallet.
- **Easily shareable:** Students can share their digital credentials with potential employers and showcase their achievements on LinkedIn and other social media platforms such as Facebook, X, Instagram and more.
- **Adjustable Privacy Settings:** Students have full control over sharing their achievements. Digital credentials can be discoverable on search engines or set to private and shared only with selected people.
- **Printable:** Digital credentials can easily be printed as high-quality PDFs.
- **Verifiable:** Employers can verify digital credentials with a click.
