IMPORTANT: How to Access the OEAA Secure Site

On November 7, 2024, the Office of Educational Assessment and Accountability (OEAA) switched from Michigan Education Information System (MEIS) to MiLogin for Business to provide users with access to the OEAA Secure Site.

To access the OEAA Secure Site through Mi-Login for Business on or after November 7, users will complete these steps:

 <u>Go to MiLogin for Business</u> (https://milogintp.michigan.gov/eai/tplogin/authenticate).

Note: Users should bookmark this page on their systems, as this is how the OEAA Secure Site will be accessed.

- a. If you have already created a MiLogin for Business account, log in with your User ID and the password you created.
- b. If you have not already created a MiLogin for Business account, select the Create an Account button on the sign-in page.
- Once logged in, go to Discover Online Services at the top-right and click on Find Services.
- From the Filter by Departments listing, select Michigan Department of Education (MDE).
- 4. From the list of available online services, select Office of Educational Assessment and Accountability (OEAA) Secure Site.

- Read the Terms & Conditions, select the I agree to the Terms & Conditions checkbox, and click the Request Service button.
- 6. When presented with the message, "Your request is being processed", click the **Continue** button.

You will be notified via email when access to the OEAA Secure Site service is granted.

 Logout of MiLogin by selecting the down arrow next to your name in the upper right-hand corner and select Logout.

After receiving the email that you have been granted access to the Secure Site:

 Log back into MiLogin. On your MiLogin home screen you should see the new system added to your list of MDE systems selections.

Note: MiLogin can react differently with different browsers. If you logged out and logged back in and do not see the OEAA Secure Site link option, close all browser windows and tabs before logging back in to MiLogin.

- 2. Click on the Office of Educational Assessment and Accountability (OEAA) Secure Site link to launch the Secure Site service.
 - a. If you had access to the OEAA Secure Site previously AND have successfully linked your MEIS account with your MiLogin for Business account by November 6, 2024, you will be logged into the OEAA Secure Site with all your prior access retained.
 - b. If you are a new user who did not previously have access to the OEAA Secure Site, or if you were not able to link your existing MEIS account for the OEAA Secure Site and your MiLogin for Business account, you will need to complete the form on the Request Access page to get the access you need.

Once you are logged into the OEAA Secure Site through MiLogin for Business, you will see no change to the appearance or functionality of the site.

PSAT 10, and PSAT 8/9 opened on Monday, October 28, 2024, and will close on November 20, 2024. During this window, schools that did not meet the auto-establishment rules can indicate their intent to participate in the required Spring 2025 administrations.

The ACT-hosted <u>State of Mich-</u> igan ACT WorkKeys <u>State Test-</u> ing website (https://www.act.org/ stateanddistrict/michigan) has been updated for Spring 2025, including the <u>Schedule of Events</u> (https://content.act.org/michigan/r/Schedule_of_Events_for_ WorkKeys_-_Michigan_-_Spring).

Select the **WorkKeys on Paper** tab at the top of the home page to view the Important Dates and Quick Links options, as well as the multiple ways to contact ACT and the Office of Educational Assessment and Accountability (OEAA).

The seven steps of the WorkKeys administration and their applicable resources are listed under the blue banner area. Select the number of each step to quickly access it or simply scroll down the page.

- Step 1: Orientation helps you become familiar with the testing program
- Step 2: Configuration provides links to systems, such as the PearsonAccess^{next} website

Step 3: Accommodation explains the accommodations and accessibility supports that are available for WorkKeys

Step 5: Administration

provides guidance to successful test administration with links to documentation, including Test Administration Forms, Administration Manuals, and Calculator Policy

 materials, with links to specific portions of the applicable
 manuals
- Step 7: Interpretation provides guidance in understanding and interpreting the score reports
