#### Pre-Identification and Material Orders for SAT, PSAT, WorkKeys, M-STEP, and MI-Access

At this time, districts and schools are to be working on their Pre-Identification Student report in the Office of Educational Assessment and Accountability (OEAA) <u>Secure Site</u> (www.michigan.gov/oeaa-secure) for the Spring 2023 SAT, PSAT 8/9, PSAT 10, WorkKeys, M-STEP, and MI-Access administrations.

Schools/districts will receive their paper/pencil assessment materials and printed barcode labels based on the students who they pre-identify in the Secure Site **by 5:00 p.m., February 15, 2023**.

### Off-Site Requests Now Open for ACT WorkKeys, MI-Access, and M-STEP

If your school or district is planning to administer the ACT WorkKeys, MI-Access, and/or M-STEP assessments at off-site locations, you must complete an Off-Site Test Administration Request(s) through the Office of Educational Assessment and Accountability (OEAA) Secure Site (www.michigan.gov/oeaa-secure).

## WIDA ACCESS for ELLs Materials Arrive in Districts on January 30

Districts can expect to receive their WIDA ACCESS for ELLs and WIDA Alternate ACCESS for ELLs test materials on **Monday, January 30, 2023**. Ensure staff are available to receive and sign for the materials. The Additional Materials Ordering window opens on this date as well, in <u>WIDA AMS</u> (https://www.drcedirect. com/all/eca-portal-v2-ui/#/login/WIDA).

The initial test materials will be shipped to the address that is listed in <u>WIDA AMS</u> under **Materials > Material Ordering**. Locate and verify your address by selecting the correct administration and district filter, then clicking on **Show Materials**. The address will be at the bottom of the **Order Materials** sub-tab.

#### Michigan-Specific WIDA Test Administration Manual Available

The Michigan-specific version of the <u>WIDA Test</u> <u>Administration Manual (TAM)</u> (https://www.michigan. gov/-/media/Project/Websites/mde/OEAA/WIDA-Assessments/WIDA\_Michigan\_Specific\_TAM.pdf) is now available at <u>www.michigan.gov/wida</u>. The generic TAM, available through the <u>WIDA website</u> (https://wida. wisc.edu) website, is used by the more than 40 states and territories that administer the WIDA assessments. The Michigan TAM is more comprehensive than the generic WIDA TAM, as it includes references to important and necessary Michigan-specific resources and tasks, such as those related to the state's Office of Educational Assessment and Accountability (OEAA) <u>Secure Site</u> (www.michigan.gov/oeaa-secure).

#### Pre-identify Students and Order WorkKeys Test Materials

The window to submit student data for pre-identification barcode labels and to order ACT WorkKeys standard-time and accommodations materials is **January 4 – February 15, 2023**, 5:00 p.m., using the <u>OEAA Secure Site</u> (www.michigan. gov/oeaa-secure).

Instructions for these activities can be found at the <u>Secure Site Training web page</u> (www.michigan.gov/ securesitetraining) under the **Pre-Identification of Students** and the **Material Ordering** sections.

Initial material orders for Standard Time, Regular Print WorkKeys materials will be based on the number of students pre-identified on the OEAA Secure Site **by 5:00 p.m. on February 15, 2023**. Accommodated materials and Spanish test booklets (if needed) must be ordered through the OEAA Secure Site on the **Initial Material Orders** page **by 5:00 p.m. on February 15, 2023**.

The projected number of Standard Time, Regular Print materials that will be sent based on the preidentification can be viewed on the Initial Material Orders page on the OEAA Secure Site. The number of Standard Time, Regular Print materials can only be adjusted by pre-identifying additional students and by unassigning students from the testing. Accommodated and Spanish materials orders will automatically reduce the number of Standard Time booklets. These materials will automatically be included in the initial test materials shipment: barcode labels, answer documents, administration manuals, Test Administration Forms folders, a small overage of Regular Print English test books, return labels, and other ancillary materials.

All test materials will be sent to the WorkKeys Test Coordinator's mailing address (not the building address) as listed in the Educational Entity Master (EEM) (www.michigan.gov/eem) as of February 15, 2023. #### **Completing Manage Participation**

The window for completing Managing Participation is **past due**. If your school(s) has not yet completed Manage Participation using the <u>PearsonAccess</u><sup>next</sup> <u>website</u> (https://testadmin.act.org), do so as soon as possible.

This process takes approximately five minutes, and step-by-step instructions are provided in the <u>ACT WorkKeys Spring 2023 Manage Participation</u> (https://www.michigan.gov/mde/-/media/Project/ Websites/mde/OEAA/MME/ACT\_WorkKeys\_ Manage\_Participation\_Guide\_-\_Michigan.pdf) located on the <u>MME web page</u> (www.michigan.gov/ mme).

The names of the schools that will be participating are sent to the Office of Educational Assessment and Accountability (OEAA) Secure Site daily. District and Building Assessment Coordinators can verify each school's status by reviewing the Test Center Participation page on the <u>OEAA Secure Site</u> (www. michigan.gov/oeaa-secure) under the **Assessment Registration** drop-down menu.

District Assessment Coordinators should ensure that all high schools in the district have completed the Manage Participation process, even if they are not testing.

#### Student Preparation – Go for Platinum!

Encourage students to understand the types of questions they will see in ACT WorkKeys, since it is different than other types of exams. Students and teachers can access free practice questions from all three tests, ranging from easier content to the most difficult. Teachers may use these practice questions as Questions of the Day or as warm-up activities in the weeks leading up to test day.

Students can also create a user account and take free full-length online practice tests (https://testregistration.org/rsp/Login. do?event=go&realm=20770563). Students can pace themselves in real-time test scenarios and receive scores indicating how they might perform on the WorkKeys assessments.
