Spring 2024 Michigan SAT Suite Testing Window Open April 8 – 26 (note correct date)

On February 5, test coordinators who utilized Test Day Toolkit in Fall 2023 received an email saying the Spring 2024 testing window for the Michiganprovided SAT with Essay, PSAT 8/9, and PSAT 10 will open on March 4. This date is incorrect; please disregard communications that include the wrong date information.

The correct dates of the testing window for the Spring 2024 Michigan-provided SAT with Essay, PSAT 8/9, and PSAT 10 is April 8 - 26. Students will not be able to access their tests until April 8.

Critical Bluebook Update Released

A critical update to the Bluebook[™] testing app was released on February 8, 2024. Unless blocked, Bluebook will auto-update the next time it is opened on testing devices.

To avoid overwhelming your network and causing delays on test day, ask students to open Bluebook themselves before test day. They don't need to sign in for the update to take place.

If your managed devices don't allow Bluebook autoupdates, perform manual updates to make sure testing devices are running the latest version of Bluebook. Also, remember to check for new releases every Friday on Bluebook Updates (https://bluebook. collegeboard.org/technology/updates). Students must always use the latest version of Bluebook while testing.

Optional Student Information in Digital Readiness Check

All testing students must complete the digital readiness check before testing in Spring 2024. The digital readiness check will ensure that the devices used in testing meet technical requirements and that Bluebook is installed correctly before students begin testing.

During the digital readiness check, students will review test taker rules, provide optional information (if permitted), and have the opportunity to experience a test preview. PSAT 10 and SAT with Essay testers can opt into the BigFuture School app and Connections, and all SAT testers can take advantage of four "free score sends".

Note: Students taking PSAT 8/9 will be presented with only the opportunity to answer the optional questions. Due to their ages, PSAT 8/9 testers are not eligible to access BigFuture School or Connections.

REMINDERS

Michigan Testing Manuals

Michigan-specific testing manuals are now available for the SAT with Essay, PSAT 10, and PSAT 8/9 assessments. There are two manuals – one for test coordinators and one for proctors. The Test Coordinator and Proctor manuals are posted on the <u>Michigan MME web page</u> (www.michigan.gov/mme) and Michigan <u>PSAT web page</u> (www.michigan.gov/psat).

School test coordinators are required to read both the Test Coordinator and Proctor manuals. Proctors are required to read the Proctor manual. Links and descriptions for each manual are provided in the table below.

Changes to MDE Consent Policy for Optional Student Information for SAT with Essay, PSAT 8/9, and PSAT 10

The process for students to access the BigFuture School app, to participate in the Connections program, and to provide optional student information during the SAT Suite of Assessments has transitioned to an "optout" policy. This means that parents/guardians will no longer need to provide consent for their students to use these resources; instead, parents will have the option to opt their students out from these activities.

Note: Students taking PSAT 8/9 will be presented with only the opportunity to answer the optional questions. Due to their ages, PSAT 8/9 testers are not eligible to access BigFuture School or Connections.

Schools must distribute the Parental/Guardian Opt-Out Form to parents and guardians on a timely basis according to district policy and collect any completed forms before testing starts. The form is available on the <u>Michigan Department of Education</u> (MDE) web page (https://bit.ly/494q4kx).

The Michigan Department of Education (MDE) requires that parents be made aware of their right to opt their students out of providing optional information. 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What's New

ACT WorkKeys Test Materials Shipments

The window to submit student data for preidentification barcode labels and to order ACT WorkKeys standard-time and accommodations materials using the <u>OEAA Secure Site</u> (www.michigan.gov/oeaa-secure) is now closed.

The quantities of standard time ACT WorkKeys materials your school will receive is based on your school's pre-ID student counts that were pulled from the OEAA Secure Site as of 5:00 p.m. on February 14, 2024, minus the accommodations counts entered on the Initial Material Order page.

Secure and non-secure standard time and accommodations materials be shipped for delivery in either **the week of March 18, 2024**, or **the week of March 25, 2024**, as selected by the school on the Manage Participation screen in PearsonAccess^{next}. The standard time and accommodations materials will be shipped in separate sets of boxes and may be delivered on different days within the selected delivery week.

Test materials will be shipped to the WorkKeys Test Coordinator's mailing address (not the building address) that is listed in <u>Educational Entity Master</u> (<u>EEM</u>) (www.michigan.gov/eem). FedEx tracking information will be available beginning March 18, 2024, on the **Material Order Reports** page on the <u>OEAA Secure Site</u> (www.michigan.gov/oeaa-secure). You can access the **Material Order Summary Report** under the **Assessment Registration** menu and the sub-menu of **Material Orders**.

If you do not receive your test materials by March 29, 2024, call ACT at 800-967-5539 for resolution.

Within 24 hours of receiving the shipment(s), compare the packing list to the materials received, using the guidelines found in the <u>ACT Test</u> <u>Coordinator Information Manual</u> (https://www.act. org/content/dam/act/secured/documents/pdfs/statedistrict-test-coordinator-paper-test.pdf). This manual is posted on the <u>ACT state testing website</u> (http://www. act.org/stateanddistrict/michigan) on the **WorkKeys on Paper** page in the **Administration** stage.
