### Online Testing: M-STEP Text-to-Speech (TTS) for Directions Functionality

The planned update that would have required students who are testing online to listen to TTS for directions before the "Next" button is active will **not** be implemented for the Spring 2023 administration. TTS for directions will function the same way that it functioned for the Spring 2022 administration. Specifically:

- All tests without TTS assigned have the option for the student to select "Play" to listen to TTS for Directions.
- All tests with TTS assigned will automatically begin playing the directions.

**Reminder:** All tests have a Welcome Screen and Audio Check screen that Test Administrators must provide directions for before TTS for Directions begins. Test Administrators are to preview and follow the directions provided in the Online Test Administrator's Directions and Manual documents.

The M-STEP Test Administration Manual (TAM) has been updated to reflect this change. The TAM can be accessed on the M-STEP web page (www. michigan.gov/mstep) under the Current Assessment Administration section.

### WIDA ACCESS for ELLs and Alternate ACCESS for ELLs – Testing Window Closure and Material Return Deadline

The WIDA ACCESS for ELLs and WIDA Alternate ACCESS for ELLs testing window closes tomorrow, **Friday, March 24, 2023**. Educators are reminded that the deadline for UPS pickup of all secure test materials for return to DRC (the testing vendor) is **Monday, April 3, 2023**.

If you have not done so already, review your paper test booklets as soon as possible. If you need additional district/school labels (yellow), please contact <a href="mailto:mde-oeaa@michigan.gov">mde-oeaa@michigan.gov</a> to order them. If you delay, you may not receive additional labels in time to ship materials back to DRC by the April 4 deadline.

Test materials not shipped by the deadline will not be processed.



## **Recently Asked Questions**

### Will students be able to take the M-STEP in a language other than English?

Yes, students testing online are able to take the M-STEP mathematics and social studies assessment using the Stacked Spanish form, which presents students with both the Spanish and English form of each test question. Other options such as the use of Spanish and Arabic flash drives for students taking the paper/pencil science and social studies tests are also available. #### Which English learner students can use glossing?

Students who would benefit the most from glossing are current English learners or possibly former English learners. The best fit for glossing is students who have an intermediate to high English proficiency. ### Action Required: Complete Required Online Training

All test coordinators are required to complete the College Board test coordinator training (http://professionaltraining.collegeboard.org) each year. If you have not yet completed training for the Spring 2023 assessments, do so as soon as possible and prior to test date.

#### **Additional Material Order Window**

Schools can now order additional materials for the Spring 2023 assessments from the Additional Material Order page on the Office of Educational Assessment and Accountability (OEAA) Secure Site (www.michigan.gov/oeaa-secure). Inventory all testing materials shipped to you before placing an order for additional materials.

Requests for additional standard test books, answer sheets, and Coordinator Manuals for the SAT with Essay, PSAT 10, and PSAT 8/9 can be made until 11:59 p.m. on Thursday, April 6, 2023. These will be orders for additional standard test books and answer sheets for the April 12 test date.

**Note:** Accommodated materials cannot be ordered from the OEAA Secure Site. Shipment of accommodated materials is based on the student submissions in the College Board SSD Online System as of February 21, 2023.

Schools that will be on spring break the week of April 3, 2023, are to place any additional material orders no later than **2:00 p.m. on March 24, 2023** (before leaving for spring break) to receive their additional materials by March 31, 2023.

A <u>College Board Testing Materials Diagram</u> (https://www.michigan.gov/mde/-/media/Project/Websites/mde/OEAA/MME/Test-Material-Diagram-MI-13123.pdf) has been posted to the <u>MME webpage</u> (www.michigan.gov/mme) and the <u>PSAT webpage</u> (www.michigan.gov/psat). The diagram summarizes the key items associated with the Spring 2023 testing materials.

### **SAT with Essay Test Book Colors**

Students will use purple test books if they are testing without accommodations or testing with certain accommodations that require the student to test on April 12 (or April 25 for the makeup). Students will use **blue** test books if they are approved for College Board accommodations that allow testing in the accommodated testing window. Students will use **green** test books if they are approved for state-allowed accommodations that allow testing in the accommodated testing window. The Nonstandard Administration Report (NAR) in SSD Online shows which test book color a student should use.

### PSAT 10 and PSAT 8/9 Test Book Shape Icons

In Michigan, shape icons are used to designate test book usage for PSAT-related assessments. Test books in the initial shipment of materials to be used for the primary and accommodated testing windows will be identified by the following shapes:

- PSAT 8/9 for Grade 8 test books
   apple icon
- PSAT 8/9 for Grade 9 test books
   = crescent icon
- PSAT 10 test book= sun icon

Schools administering both grade 8 and grade 9 assessments must keep the test books for each grade separate. Students in grade 8 and those in grade 9 cannot test together and must use the correct, grade-specific test book. Student use of the incorrect test book will result in an invalidated score.

### Pre-Recorded Audio (MP3 via Streaming) Action Required

Students approved for the pre-recorded audio accommodation during testing will receive their audio through an online streaming application. To ensure a successful test day experience, administrators are encouraged to install and test the application ahead of test day on all computers intended for test administration using this accommodation. Early readiness is essential to avoid potential issues on test day.

To install the application and run a sample test form:

- Go to the College Board MP3 Streaming Application page in <u>SSD Online</u> (https://ssdonline. collegeboard.org/)
- 2. Select the link for MP3 Streaming
- 3. Follow the instructions

Access to SSD Online is necessary for access to the MP3 application. For proctors who will administer the test but do not have access to SSD Online, test coordinators will receive a separate access code and instructions during the week of April 3, which will allow proctors to access the MP3 application.

If the application was installed and used for Fall 2022 testing, it does not have to be re-installed for this spring's testing.

### **Test Materials Shipments**

Secure and non-secure standard time and accommodations materials have been shipped for delivery either this week or next week, as selected by the school on the Manage Participation screen in PearsonAccess<sup>next</sup>. The standard time and accommodations materials will be shipped in separate sets of boxes and may be delivered on different days within the selected delivery week.

Test materials will be shipped to the WorkKeys Coordinator's mailing address (not the building address) that is listed in <u>Educational Entity Master</u> (<u>EEM</u>) (www.michigan.gov/eem) as of February 15, 2023.

FedEx tracking information is posted on the Material Order Reports page in the Office of Educational Assessment and Accountability (OEAA) Secure Site (www.michigan.gov/oeaa-secure) as materials are shipped. You can access the Material Order Summary Report under the Assessment Registration menu and the sub-menu of Material Orders.

If after checking in your test materials you find the number of students scheduled to test April 13-26, 2023, exceeds the number of test materials received, order additional ACT WorkKeys materials through the OEAA Secure Site (www.michigan.gov/oeaa-secure) through April 6, 2023, at 5:00 p.m. Do not submit additional materials orders in PearsonAccess<sup>next</sup>.
