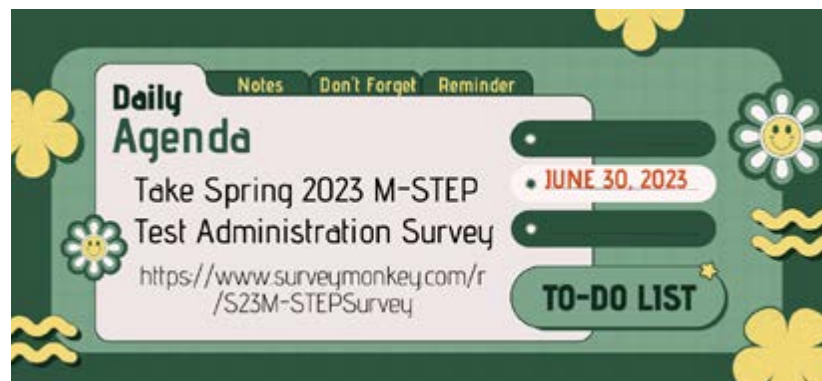
### Spring 2023 MI-Access Test Post-Administration Survey

## Reminders

### Test Security Change for DRC INSIGHT

Beginning June 30, 2023, Data Recognition Corporation (DRC) is implementing a security enhancement that will impact Michigan's online assessments. This security change impacts the Early Literacy and Mathematics Benchmark Assessment testing starting with the Fall 2023 administration, as well as the Spring 2024 online administrations of M-STEP and MI-Access.

Local school/district IT staff will be required to change the way they update the DRC INSIGHT Secure Browser software on testing devices. Moving forward, only administrator-level users will be allowed to update the DRC INSIGHT Secure Browser on Windows and macOS testing devices.



- Districts and schools that **are/will be impacted:**
  - » Sites that manually update the INSIGHT browser on each Windows or Mac testing device
  - » Sites that have enabled the auto-update feature for the INSIGHT browser – auto-update will no longer be an option after the security enhancement is implemented
- Districts and schools that **are not/will not be impacted:**
  - » Sites that use iPad or ChromeOS devices for testing
  - » Sites that use deployment software to update multiple testing devices at once

**Action needed:** Impacted school/district users must ensure the INSIGHT secure browser is updated as soon as possible after June 30, 2023, before student testing is scheduled to begin. This updating is necessary to allow students to test after June 30.

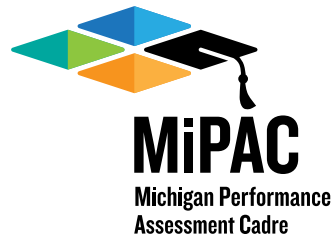

### Development Opportunity: Michigan Performance Assessment Cadre of Experts (MiPAC) – Cohort IV

Join the Office of Educational Assessment and Accountability as we work with the Michigan Assessment Consortium to develop performance assessments aligned to Michigan's model competencies in mathematics and English language arts (ELA) in grades 3-5 and 6-8.



- practice scoring of performance assessments with colleagues
- participate in a research agenda focused on measuring student competencies through performance assessments
- earn up to 50 SCECH credits
  - » stipends will also be available, based on time and completed products.

Participants are expected to attend and contribute approximately 50 hours of job-embedded facilitated professional learning and assessment development over the 2022-23 academic year.

Cohort IV will meet in-person three times for 5 days total, plus attend two 2-hour virtual sessions (after school) from August 2023 through June 2024. Participants will work in grade-range teams with colleagues. Team leads may host 2-3 additional virtual team meetings throughout the year to keep the item development momentum going and production flowing.

A stipend covering anticipated assessment development time, as well as travel expenses (and sub fees) for in-person meetings to be held in the Lansing area, are offered to all Cohort IV team members.

- wish to work with other educators on a stimulating collaborative endeavor

### WHAT'S NEW

#### Educator Score Release

Scores for the SAT with Essay, PSAT 8/9, and PSAT 10 will be released to educators via the College Board K-12 Reporting Portal tomorrow, June 23, 2023.

**Note:** All test results are embargoed until the Michigan Department of Education issues a notification that the results may be released publicly, in late summer or early fall.

The embargo will be lifted when school- and district-aggregated test results are made publicly available through [MI School Data](https://www.mischooldata.org) (<https://www.mischooldata.org>).
