Translated Parent Reports for the M-STEP, PSAT Grade 8, MME, and MI-Access assessments are now available in Arabic, in addition to Spanish and English.

To access translated versions of Parent Reports, log into the <u>OEAA Secure Site</u> (www.michigan.gov/oeaa-secure), and select **Dynamic Score Reporting Site** under the **Reports** tab:




Next, select the **Test Cycle** and entity information and **Open Report** to open the **Dynamic Score Reporting Site**:

### **Digital SAT with Essay Responses**

In Spring 2024, the Michigan Department of In Spring 2024, the PSAT 8/9, PSAT 10, and SAT with Essay will be administered digitally. Students will enter their item responses into the student testing application called <a href="Bluebook">Bluebook</a> (https://bluebook.collegeboard.org/). For the digital SAT with Essay, this includes students typing their essay responses.

The Essay section is required as part of the Michigan Merit Exam (MME). Although essay responses will be submitted digitally, the prompt style and the length of the Essay section (that is, 50 minutes) will remain the same as in previous SAT School Day administrations.

## School Establishment and the Educational Entity Master (EEM)

School establishment is the process through which Michigan schools are identified as participating in the state assessments and are set up for digital testing in College Board systems.

It is important for schools to update their information in the <u>Educational Entity Master (EEM)</u> (http://www.michigan.gov/eem), which serves as Michigan's repository of education systems and contact information.

College Board will use the data in EEM to identify contact information for testing staff and to establish schools for testing. In addition to test coordinators, backup test coordinators, and Services for Students with Disabilities (SSD) Coordinators, building level technology coordinators must be assigned in EEM in order for schools to be set up for testing.

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For each College Board assessment (SAT with Essay, PSAT 10, and PSAT 8/9 for grades 8 and 9), the following information is required for school test coordinators, backup school test coordinators, SSD Coordinators, and technology coordinators:

- · First Name
- · Last Name
- Email
- Telephone Number
- Complete Entity Physical Address (Street Address, City, State, Zip Code)

**Note:** The mailing address must be the physical district or school address associated with the test coordinator record. Make sure each of the fields above is accurate and complete for all applicable roles. Any incorrect data in EEM could delay your school's establishment process.
