- ** The “Recommended” dates are benchmarks for the LEA to use. If recommended dates are met, it is more likely the LEA will meet “Submission” deadlines to the MDE.

Closing Phase

October 1, 2024	The Final Expenditure Report (FER) for 2023-24 grants is available in NexSys <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • FERs are available as soon as the LEA has expended the last of the available allocation or on October 1, whichever comes first
November 29, 2024	Final submission date of the FER for 2023-24 grants. Carryover is automatically calculated and incorporated into the 2024-25 Consolidated Application when the FER is certified in NexSys.
June 2025	Regular school year closes. Supplementary summer programs begin.

The Consolidated Application is substantially-approvable if ALL the following conditions are met:

- a. The Plan in MICIP has clearly-defined needs, goals, strategies, and activities that directly support the highest priority academic needs of schools and LEAs; and directly supports the academic needs of ELs, students experiencing homelessness or foster care, migratory, neglected, and delinquent eligible students; and
- b. The Title I Targeted and Schoolwide Program template is uploaded as an attachment to the Title I, Part A Application in NexSys by the final amendment window; and
- c. The Application is submitted with all the required elements including budgets that align to the strategies and activities within the Plan (supplies, materials, equipment, contracts, and staffing to be funded by the programs), and other applicable supporting documents; and
- d. The Application demonstrates that the Plan being funded is focused on improving academic achievement, is comprehensive and cohesive; and
- e. Each funded activity is reasonable, necessary, allowable, allocable, consistent with Federal and State laws, regulations, and guidance, and meets the intent and purpose of each Federal grant source included in the Application; and
- f. School-level budgets are completed for all Title I, Part A schools, and if applicable, Title II, Part A and Title IV, Part A if used to transfer into Title I, Part A; and
- g. The Title I, Part A Homeless Set Aside Reservation has been included.

NOTE: The MDE recommends the LEA apply for 100% of the posted allocations
