### Evaluation II Phase

Key Date	Activity
December 2022 - March 2023	* LEAs conduct formal evaluation of MICIP
March 2023	The LEA central office reviews evaluation data to determine effectiveness and impact on student achievement

- \* Evaluation of programs implemented for 12 months or more. Title III requires an annual evaluation that is submitted to the MDE biennially in conjunction with the Section 41 Program Report or as an attachment in the Consolidated Application if the recipient does not accept Section 41 funding.
- \*\* The "Recommended" dates are benchmarks for the LEA to use. If recommended dates are met, it is more likely the LEA will meet "submission" deadlines to the MDE.
- \*\*\* The Consolidated Application must be submitted in substantially-approvable form (see bottom of page 3). Timely LEA responses required.

### Closing Phase

Key Date	Activity
October 1, 2022	The Final Expenditure Report (FER) for 2021-22 grants is available in NexSys
November 29, 2022	<b>Final submission date</b> of the FER for 2021-22 grants. Carryover is automatically calculated and incorporated into the 2022-23 Consolidated Application when the FER is certified in NexSys.
June 2023	Regular school year closes. Supplementary summer programs begin.

**The Consolidated Application is substantially-approvable if ALL of the following conditions are met:**

- a. The Plan in MICIP has clearly-defined needs, goals, strategies, and activities that directly support the highest priority academic needs of schools and LEAs; and directly supports the academic needs of English Learners, students experiencing homelessness or foster care, migratory, neglected, and delinquent eligible students; and
- b. The Application is submitted with all of the required elements including budgets that align to the strategies and activities within the Plan (supplies, materials, equipment, contracts, and staffing to be funded by the programs), and other applicable supporting documents; and
- c. The Application demonstrates that the Plan being funded is focused on improving academic achievement, is comprehensive and cohesive; and
- d. Each activity being funded is reasonable, necessary, allowable, allocable, consistent with Federal and State laws, regulations, and guidance, and meets the intent and purpose of each Federal grant source included in the Application; and
- e. School-level budgets are completed for all Title I, Part A schools, and if applicable, Title II, Part A and Title IV, Part A if used to transfer into Title I, Part A.

**NOTE:** The MDE recommends the LEA apply for 100% of the posted allocations
