

Function Codes	Allowable Function Codes for Title III, Part A – Language Instruction for Immigrant Students
125	<b>Compensatory Education:</b> Costs for supplementary instructional services provided to eligible Title III eligible immigrant students.
211	<b>Truancy/Absenteeism Services:</b> Costs for activities to improve the attendance of eligible Title III eligible immigrant students.
212	<b>Guidance Services:</b> Costs for counseling services provided to eligible Title III Immigrant students.
213	<b>Health Services:</b> Costs for health services provided to eligible Title III Immigrant students.
214	<b>Psychological Services:</b> Costs for psychological services provided to eligible Title III Immigrant students above and beyond what is provided by the LEAs or IEPs.
216	<b>Social Work Services:</b> Costs for school social work services provided to eligible Title III Immigrant students above and beyond what is provided by the LEAs or IEPs
221	<b>Improvement of Instruction:</b> Costs for supplementary professional development for instructional staff designed to benefit Title III eligible immigrant students.
222	<b>Educational Media Services:</b> Costs for acquiring and planning the use of educational media for the instruction of eligible Title III eligible immigrant students.
224	<b>Educational Television:</b> Costs for acquiring, planning, and presenting educational programs by way of television for the instruction of eligible Title III eligible immigrant students.
225	<b>Computer-Assisted Instruction:</b> Costs for Title III Immigrant instructional activities when a computer is the principal medium of instruction <b>used in a computer lab</b> (e.g., hardware, software, computer labs, secure workstations).
226	<b>Supervision and Direction of Instructional Staff:</b> Costs necessary to direct and manage the Title III Immigrant program. <b>(administrative and indirect costs cannot exceed a total 2% cap)</b>
227	<b>Academic Student Assessment:</b> Diagnostic testing of eligible Title III eligible immigrant students and testing necessary to evaluate the Title III Immigrant program.
231	<b>Board of Education:</b> Costs for external audits of the Title III Immigrant program. <b>(administrative and indirect costs cannot exceed a total 2% cap).</b>
252	<b>Fiscal Services:</b> Costs necessary for Title III Immigrant budgeting, accounting, and purchasing. <b>(administrative and indirect costs cannot exceed a total 2% cap)</b>
271	<b>Pupil Transportation Services:</b> Costs for pupil transportation necessary for Title III Immigrant program operation.
281	<b>Planning, Research, Development, and Evaluation:</b> Costs for Title III Immigrant program evaluation.

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282	<b>Communication Services:</b> Costs for preparing Title III Immigrant educational information to disseminate to pupils, staff, or the public (e.g., supplies, postage, and preparation for parent communications).
283	<b>Staff/Personnel Services:</b> Costs for supplementary professional development for non-instructional staff designed to benefit Title III eligible immigrant students.
284	<b>Information Management Services:</b> Costs for preparing, storing, and retrieving Title III Immigrant education data.
331	<b>Community Activities:</b> Costs for Title III Immigrant parent engagement activities.
361	<b>Welfare Activities:</b> Costs to provide for the personal needs of needy Title III Immigrant eligible students.
371	<b>Non-Public School Pupils:</b> Costs of providing Title III Immigrant services to pupils attending private schools and professional development for private school staff.
