(CACFP) Trainings

**ACTION: Registration Process for Trainings** 

Recordkeeping Training on the Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP) will be offered at nine (9) locations with nine (9) full recordkeeping sessions. The CACFP trainings are free and are designed for new staff, as well as staff desiring a program refresher or training in any specific topic area. Personnel responsible for ensuring program compliance may attend a session to comply with corrective action from an administrative review. In addition, certificates will be available upon completion of the training and can be used toward annual training required by the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services.

Registration for CACFP trainings is required due to limited seating. Individuals registering for CACFP trainings must create an account on the <a href="Eventbrite website">Eventbrite website</a> (www.Eventbrite.com). Save your account information as CACFP staff will not have access to that information. The registration process for Eventbrite is posted on the <a href="CACFP website">CACFP website</a> (www.michigan.gov/cacfp) under Training. Registration instructions are also attached to this memo. # Child and Adult Care Food Program Fiscal Year 2018 Training Eventbrite Online Registration Instructions

### To register:

- 1. Go to the **Eventbrite website** (www.Eventbrite.com).
- 2. Create an account, which will require an email address and a password. Please save your account information.
- 3. Search for CACFP trainings by the city of the training location or by the training date. You may also type: Child and Adult Care Food Program in the search field to bring up all sessions.
- 4. Complete the required registration information:
  - First Name and Last Name
  - E-Mail Address
  - Job Title
  - Company/Organization Name
  - Work Phone Number
  - CACFP Agreement Number. If no agreement number, type "applying" in this field.
  - County Name (example Ingham, Wayne, Oakland, etc.) Do not type Michigan.
  - Sponsor (multiple feeding sites) or Independent (single feeding site)
     Check the appropriate box. Choose only one.
  - Select the session(s) you would like to attend.
- 5. Review your information. When the required fields are complete, click "complete registration." Print registration confirmation.
- 6. To cancel a reservation, go to <u>Eventbrite website</u> (www.Eventbrite.com), log in, and cancel the reservation.
