## **New to the Summer Food Service Program?**

The SFSP is a federally-funded program, and it is run in our state by the Michigan Department of Education. The SFSP reimburses sponsors of the program who serve free healthy meals to children and teens in low-income areas during the summer months when school is not in session.

#### **Cool Tools to Check Site Eligibility**

There are two ways to find out if a site is eligible, school data or census data. First check school data and if the site does not qualify then check census data. Easy to follow instructions and cool tools that help with checking census data are on the SFSP website here: Site Eligibility17
