After-School/Summer Learning - Community-Based Organization -

The Michigan Department of Education (MDE) is pleased to announce the availability of grant funds to provide before- and after-school and/or summer learning in-person programming to serve children in kindergarten through grade 8.

This grant opportunity is not for districts. The purpose of this memo is to inform local districts of this grant opportunity should they choose to work with a community partner to bring programming into their district.

Section 23e of Public Act 3 of 2021 allocates \$5 million to be awarded through a competitive process to community-based organizations (CBOs) to provide beforeand after-school and/or summer learning programming to children in kindergarten through grade 8. As described in this law, CBOs must provide educational programming in core subject areas, including but not limited to, mathematics, reading, and science. Programming must be provided through an in-person format at a building designated by the eligible entity.
