



Child Nutrition Programs (CNP) Bulletin

October 26, 2021 - Child Nutrition Programs (CNP) Bulletin - August 2021 Claims are Due on Monday, November 1, 2021

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August 2021 School Nutrition Program (NSLP and SSO) and the Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) claims are due no later than **Monday, November 1, 2021**. Please reference [Administrative Memo No. 4](#) for School Year 2021-2022 for the SNP claim due dates and [Operational Memorandum #2](#) for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 for SFSP claim due dates. Failure to submit your claim by this due date will result in a late claim. The Michigan Department of Education only has the authority to approve payment of one late claim or amendment, in each program, within a 36-month period.

If the 2021-2022 school year began in August, school year meals served must be claimed under the School Nutrition Program claim in [MIND 2.0](#). If a sponsor participated in the SFSP in August, SFSP meals must be submitted under the SFSP claim in [MIND 2.0](#). Thus, you may have two separate claims for August.

Reminder that all claims are now submitted in MIND 2.0. You must create a [MILogin for Third Party](#) account and link that account to your current MEIS account. [Instructions](#) on how to complete this are available.

The [Michigan Electronic Grant System Plus \(MEGS+\) 2022](#) Child Nutrition Programs (CNP) School Nutrition Program (SNP) Application was due September 30, 2021. If you have not submitted the application or requested modifications, please do so now.

In order to enter and certify a claim, you must have an approved 2022 CNP School Nutrition Program application.
