

### CHART 5 – “No Eval Emergency Order” Rating

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The approximate release date for effectiveness ratings is the 3rd week of July. Educators in their 3rd year of teaching who wish to progress to the Professional Teaching or CTE Certificate must wait to submit the application until the ratings have been released.

- Due to the impact of COVID-19 emergency orders, all records reported in the end-of-year 2020 REP collection without an evaluation label (Highly Effective, Effective, Minimally Effective, Ineffective, or Highly Effective Educator Exemption) will have a label of “No Eval Emergency Order” applied.
