October 18, 2024 - Child Nutrition Programs (CNP) Bulletin No. 19 - UPDATE Commercial Recall: BrucePac Meat and Poultry

On October 9, 2024, BrucePac (Est. 51205/P-51205), recalled approximately 9,986,245 pounds of ready-to-eat (RTE) meat and poultry products due to *Listeria monocytogenes* contamination. On October 15, 2024, BrucePac further expanded the recall to nearly 12 million of RTE meat and poultry products. The RTE meat and poultry items impacted were produced from June 19, 2024, to October 8, 2024. These products were shipped to other establishments and distributors nationwide then distributed to restaurants and institutions, including schools. At this time, there have been no confirmed reports of adverse reactions due to the consumption of these products.

The United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Food and Nutrition Services (FNS) was recently informed that schools located across seven states (IA, FL, MI, OH, KY, WV, and WI) received recalled product through commercial channels. The USDA Food Safety and Inspection Services (FSIS) is working diligently to identify all recalled products that were distributed to consumers, including those purchased by schools. A [preliminary list of schools](#), including some Michigan schools, that received products that include BrucePac recalled RTE meat and poultry have

been added. FSIS will continue to update this and the retail product list as it receives more information.
