Estimated IDEA, Part B, Section 611, Special Education Flowthrough Allocations for FY 2024-25

As of April 19, 2024

As prescribed under IDEA 2004, the fiscal year (FY) 2024-25 **estimated** allocations are based on the following data factors:

1. Base Allocation = 75% of the federal fiscal year (FFY) 1999 award to ISDs.
2. 85% of the remaining award is distributed on a pro-rata basis according to 3-21 Public Fall 2023 Count and 3-21 Non-Public 2023 Count.
3. 15% of the remaining award is distributed on a pro-rata basis according to the Fall 2023 Free Lunch Eligibility Count.

Final awards will be calculated using the Fall 2023 audited data factors and are subject to the final federal award amount.
