Estimated IDEA, Part B, Section 619, Special Education Preschool Allocations for FY 2022-2023

As of July 19, 2022

As prescribed under IDEA 2004, the FY 2022-2023 **estimated** allocations are based on the following data factors:

1. Base Allocation = 75% of the FFY 1997 award to ISDs.
2. 85% of the remaining award is distributed on a pro rata basis according to 3-21 Public Fall 2021 Count and 3-21 Non-Public 2021-2022 Count.
3. 15% of the remaining award is distributed on a pro rata basis according to the Fall 2019 Free Lunch Eligibility Count. The MDE determined the Fall 2019 Free Lunch Count is the best data available due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Final Awards will be calculated using the 2019 and 2021 audited data factors and are subject to the final federal award amount.
