 Allocations for Fiscal Year (FY) 2023-2024

As of May 18, 2023

As prescribed under IDEA 2004, the FY 2023-2024 **estimated** allocations are based on the following data factors:

1. Base Allocation = 75% of the Federal Fiscal Year 1997 award to ISDs.
2. 85% of the remaining award is distributed on a pro rata basis according to 3-21 Public Fall 2022 Count and 3-21 Non-Public 2022-2023 Count.
3. 15% of the remaining award is distributed on a pro rata basis according to the Fall 2022 Free Lunch Eligibility Count.

Final awards will be calculated using the 2022-2023 audited data factors and are subject to the final federal award amount.
