- Turn off your phone/computer camera. You are participating in a business meeting of the SEAC. Visitors are welcomed to listen but will not participate unless asked to do so.
- Non-members are asked to remember the SEAC is a working body. Entry into small group rooms is for members only. During work times, visitors must sign out and sign back in when the entire group reconvenes (check day's agenda for time).
