


Michigan Early Hearing Detection & Intervention (EHDI) Online Access to Hearing Results

Results for hearing tests can be assessed by various healthcare providers through the Michigan Care Improvement Registry (MCIR). These results are expected to appear on the Hearing (EHDI) tab approximately two weeks after the birth of an infant.

To access the Hearing (EHDI) tab on MCIR, log in and navigate to the tab within a specific child's record. Click on the Hearing (EHDI) tab to view results for children. If the tab is not visible, it means the hearing screen results for that child have not been linked to MCIR yet. Every hearing results reported to EHDI, whether screening or diagnostic test, will be shown.

For additional information on appropriate next steps for infants requiring follow-up, click on the Follow-up Detailed Information link. It's crucial to ensure that every child receives the necessary testing.
